Acknowledgment is made of your letter requesting information concerning your husband, the late Private Frank W. Tryonas.

In view of the fact that the Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City Quartermaster Depot, Kansas City, Missouri, has been designated to receive and ship personal effects of deceased personnel overseas, a copy of your letter has been forwarded to that office for direct reply. This action has been taken in order to expedite reply and eliminate duplication of effort.

The Office, Chief of Chaplains, Washington D. C., has also been furnished a copy of your letter for direct reply to you. That office has jurisdiction over information concerning the burial rites of our deceased military personnel.

The official report of interment received in this office reveals that the remains of your husband were interred in United States Military Cemetery #1, Foy, Belgium, Grave #1, Row 3, Plot J. This cemetery is located approximately four miles northeast of Bastogne and twenty miles southeast of Marche, both in Belgium.

A notation has been made on the official records of this office that your address has been changed to 323 Second Street, Scranton, Pennsylvania.

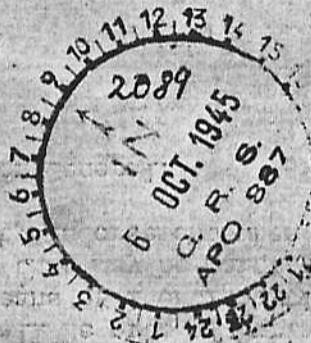

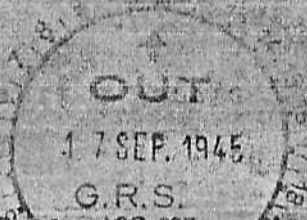

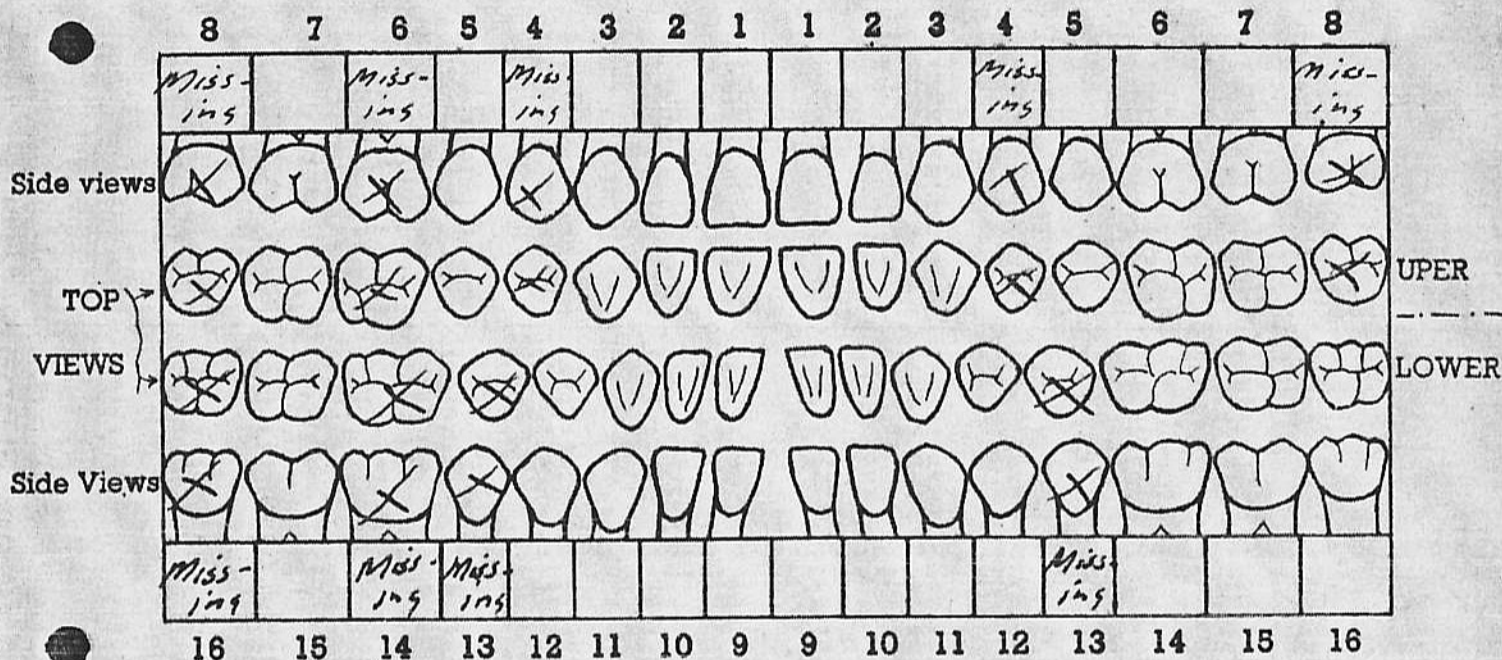

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. See reverse side for illustrations.

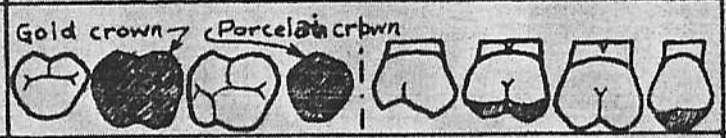

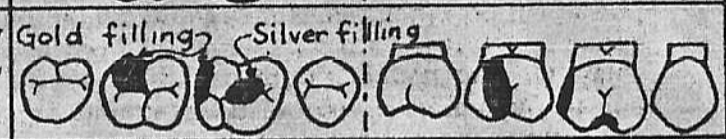
