

Dear Mrs. Johnson,

I write to you in the hope that information will be of comfort to you in this time of sorrow. Your son, Sergeant Clifford R. Johnson, 20721955, was killed in action on 12 December 1944 in Germany.

Clifford was a Squad Leader in company "C". His unit was a part of the Third United States Army, and at the time he was killed his company was participating in the winter drive into Lorraine. As company "C" was crossing the Blies River in assault boats, the boat in which Clifford was riding struck an obstacle in the river. The boat was capsized and due to very swift waters your son was drowned. This action occurred in the vicinity of Habkirchen, Germany, on the French-German border.

Words cannot be of much help at this time, but I extend to you my sincere sympathy. Your son was a courageous and alert soldier, and his memory is a proud one. That memory shall remain as a fitting tribute to his supreme sacrifice.





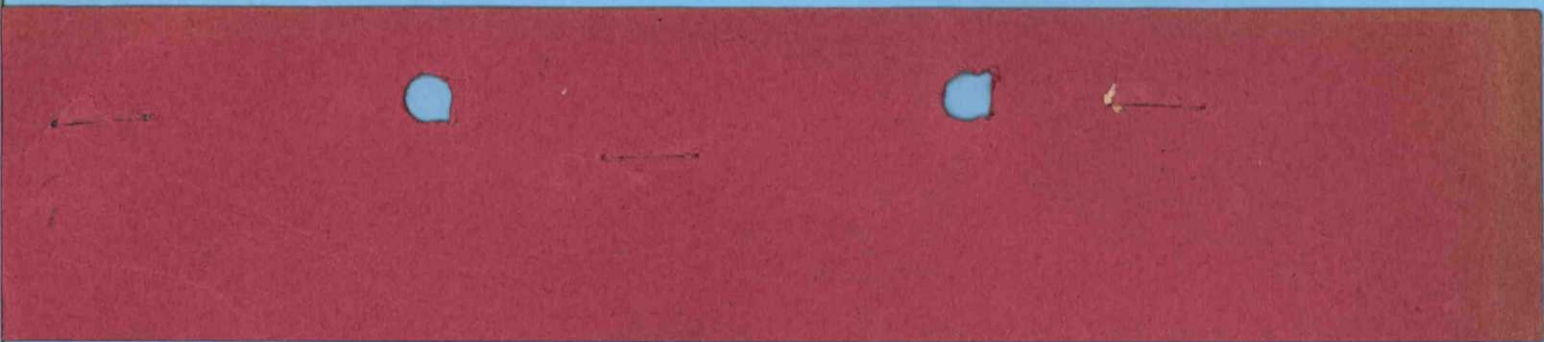
