NARRATIVE REPORT OF INVESTIGATION AT: BLIESMENGEN (K-50/Q-56)

25 January 1949

During a routine investigation in the vicinity of REINHEIM, GERSHEIM and BLIESMENGEN we ran across 2 American type ID tags which were kept by the Burgomaster of BLIESMENGEN. According to his statement these tags were found by children playing in the cemetery of BLIESMENGEN in some of the excavated earth from graves # 58 and # 50 in Row #6 after an American disinterment team had removed the remains of Wilson, Wayne and two (2) Unknowns from these graves. Since one of these tags bears the inscription: WILSON, Wayne, i.e. the name of the deceased already identified it is very possible that one of the two (2) Unknowns recovered from this cemetery can be associated with RAMOS, Diego, the name on the second ID tag.

According to information available at this Hqs. RAMOS, Diego was ain a MIS status when boat he was in, sank in the BLIES river, on the German and French border. Witnesses state that chance of survival was poor as the water was at flood stage, travelling about 15 miles an hour. The river was about 50 yards wide and these men were in the middle of the river.

Additional information i.e. the Narrative Report of Disinterment for WILSON, Wayne states that the remains and the two Unknowns recovered from the cemetery at BLIESMENGEN were found in the forest about two (2) miles from the town. The narrative report furthermore states that the above mentioned remains were found by a German, a Mr. FLIEGER, who was in charge of a German disinterring team. This Mr. FLIEGER states that he found WILSON'S ID tag on one of the deceased, which he kept and handed to the American disinterment team lateron. This might not exclude a mistake of having given the wrong name to a wrong deceased.

CONCLUSION:

It is concluded by this investigation that there is a very strong possibility that one of the three (3) deceased recovered from the cemetery in BLIESMENGEN is RAMOS, Diego, especially since his ID tag was found together with the ID tag of WILSON, Wayne, a deceased already identified.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the remains of the three (3) deceased recovered from the cemetery in BLIESMENGEN i.e. WILSON, Wayne ASN 36893634 and Unknown X-7096 and X-7098 (Neuville) be reprocessed, and an effort be made to associate two (2) of them with WILSON, Wayne and RAMOS, Diego.

On Investigation at Habkirchen, Germany (K-50/Q-55). 23 June 1947.

An investigation was conducted in the vicinity of Habkirchen, Ger. (K-50/Q-55), and the following information was obtained:

Upon arrival at Habkirchen I contacted the Burgermeister and learned that all American soldiers that had been killed in action there, were removed to the French side of the border.

I then proceeded to Bliesbruck/France where I contacted the Burger-meister and cemetery caretaker. They stated that all American deceased had been removed from this area to St. Avold, France.

After interviewing all farmers along the Blies River on both the French and German side I could find no trace of any American grave. I only learned that three Unknown American soldiers were buried there and have been previously disinterred and evacuated to St. Avold, France.

The following American Graves Registration Units have worked that area in 1946.

CONCLUSION:

I have come to the conclusion that all American deceased have been removed from the vicinity of Habkirchen and evacuated to St. Avold, France and that Pfc. BEILINGER, HAROLD D. could bery possibly be one of the Unknowns mentioned above.

SUBJECT: Report of Death

- 1. Second Lieutenant Frank E. Layton, 01317178, Infantry, was reported missing in action in Germany on 13 December 1944 by ETO Shipment No. 289 and was presumed dead as of 14 December 1945 by SR&D No. 4894.
- 2. The casualty file of the subject officer contains a Missing Report dated 14 January 1945, giving his organization as Co L, 137th Inf and disclosing that he took part in a mission to depart on 13 December 1944 from Frauenberg to go to "high ground across the river" and that his last known whereabouts was "The Blies River." The report contains the following brief resume of circumstances:

"Lt. Layton was leading a platoon, trying to cross the Blies River the boat he was in sank and we have not seen him since."

3. A letter of inquiry from this office to the Commanding General, USFET, dated 14 March 1945, was returned by 7th Indorsement, dated 8 April 1945. The 4th Indorsement, dated 1 April 1945, from Hq 137th Inf to CG, 35th Inf Div., discloses information, as follows; quoted in part:

"On morning of 13 Dec 44, the unit prepared to cross the Blies River at approximately 0700 in the morning, to assault the enemy. From the small town of Blies it was necessary to cross an open field of about 150 - 200 yds to reach the river. The river was about 30 yds in width, with the current running around 15 miles per hour. Water was at flood stage.

"The weather was cold, around 38. Visibility: Foggy. Combat uniform worn, rifles, sidearms, etc. Raincoats were carried. It is not known whether Lt. Layton could swim. An unidentified engineer pulled three men out of the river, one other reached the bank. Fifty yards to the front a German automatic weapon was firing. Rescue or capture by the enemy unlikely. Statements of survivors are not available. No systematic search made, due to tactical situation. Lt Layton was last seen in approximately the center of the river.

"It is not believed that facts are sufficient to warrant a change of status. There is the possibility that Lt Layton may have swam down stream and was captured at some other point along the river. It is felt there is a possibility of survival."

In reply to a question regarding casualty status of others who took part in the same action, the following information was furnished:

"Recommend that no change to be taken on the status of S Sgt Robert P. Shackelford, 37222952, who became MIA due to the same action.

"Names of other personnel involved in this incident are:

S/Sgt Alfred D. Hollywood, 32216186, SWA 13 December 1944 S/Sgt Robert L. Shackelford, 37222952 MIA 13 December 1944

Personnel listed below were involved in the incident but became casualties at a later date:

- 4. The Army Map Service locates Frauenberg at Coordinates 49008'N, 7008'E, in France, on the west side of the Blies River which forms the German-French border at that place. A few scattered buildings on the German side of the river are believed by the Map Service to belong to another town, not to Frauenberg.
- 5. A search of the Captured German records has resulted in failure to locate any record of the subject officer, nor has any record of him been found upon search of the records of the OQMG.
- 6. The subject officer was with his unit which was participating in a mission on 13 December 1944 to cross the Blies River from Frauenberg to go to high ground across the river. The company had to cross some 150 to 200 yards of open field in approaching the river. Fifty yards in front a German automatic weapon was firing. The weather was cold, about 38° in the morning; a foggy morning; and the soldiers were equipped with combat uniform, rifles, sidearms and carried raincoats. This officer was last seen in the center of the river, which was about 30 yards wide at this point and was flowing at about 15 miles per hour. The water was at flood stage. A communication from Hq, 137th Infantry, mentions two enlisted man who were involved in the incident but became casualties at a later date; one who was seriously wounded and one (S Sgt Shackelford) who was reported as missing in action and who was later reported killed in action, having been instantly killed by enemy sniper fire when loading men into assault

boats to cross the river. In view of the weather and river condition, the weight of equipment and the place where this officer was last seen - in the center of the swiftly flowing river, it appears practically impossible for him to have survived. No report of capture has been received. No trace of him has been found during the more than five years which have elapsed since the date he disappeared. In view of the foregoing it is concluded that he perished, when his boat capsized in the Blies River on the German-Grench border at Frauenberg, France.

7. It is recommended, therefore, that pursuant to the provisions of Section 9, Missing Persons Act, the foregoing information be accepted as an official report of death stating that the person named in paragraph one, above, was killed in action in the Blies River at Frauenberg, France, when his boat capsized and he was thown into the river on 13 December 1944. The official report of death will include the following statement:

"Finding of Death has been issued previously under Section 5, Public Law 490, 7 March 1942, as amended, showing presumed date of death as 14 December 1945. This 'Report of Death' is issued in accordance with Section 9 of said Act and its effect on prior payments and settlements is as provided in Section 9."

This memorandum will be routed to Operating Unit for notification and processing. Station and place of Death: European Area.






