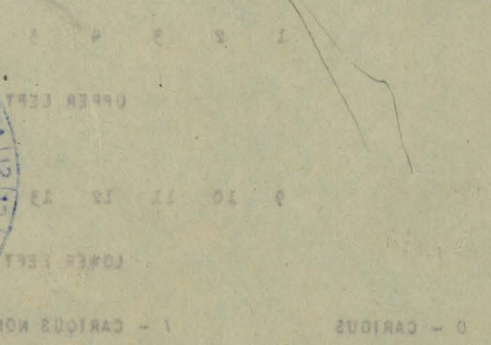

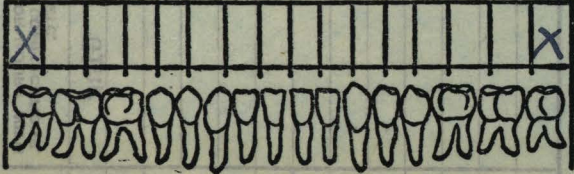
UPPER TEETH

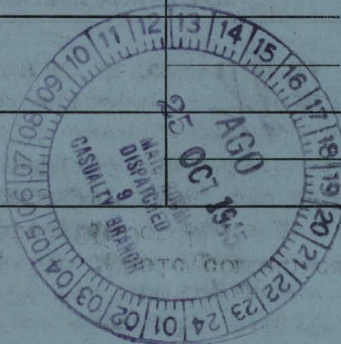

Reference is made to your recent letter in which you requested information concerning your brother, Private First Class Hubert W. Whitehead.

The distress you have suffered since your brother's death is most understandable and I realize your desire to know the attending circumstances. It is sincerely regretted that no further information has been received in the War Department other than the official message received from the Commanding General of the organization in which he was serving which states that Private Whitehead was killed in action in Germany on 12 December 1944, the date on which he was previously reported missing in action. In submitting reports of death all existing factors are carefully considered and no reports are forwarded unless there is conclusive evidence to justify such action. You may be assured in the event additional information is received, it will be conveyed to you promptly.
