The casualties listed on attached roster are re-SYNOPSIS: ported by official records as Missing in Action or Killed in Action during ground or air operations in the department of Moselle, France, from the period 5 September 1944 to 16 March 1945. Extensive area searches as well as individual investigation have to date failed to furnish information as to the ultimate disposition of their remains. Efforts to effect association with unidentified recoveries from the area, now interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries, have also proven negative. The lack of specific information regarding the death or burial, limited search in most instances to general localities, however, documents on file in this Office and Office of The Quartermaster General substantiate the fact that numerous investigations covering the entire department of Moselle have been conducted in the course of search operations for all losses, both recovered and unrecovered. terrain of the Moselle department, for the most part, consists of farm, pasture and forested areas which has been under constant cultivation and supervision by farmers and forest guards, since the cessation of hostilities, thus the possibility of undiscovered graves is remote. It can therefore be concluded that the remains of the deceased in question were reduced by battle action to a state which precludes recovery or identification. The absence of specific information concerning their deaths, the failure of Field Investigations to provide

evidence and the lack of association with recovered unknowns would tend to substantiate these conclusions. It is recommended that the remains of the individuals listed in these Board Proceedings be considered Non-Recoverable under the provisions of paragraph 3b, Letter, Office of The Quartermaster General, file QMGMP 293, Subject: Processing Board Findings of Non-Recoverability Return of World War II Pead Program, dated 25 March 1949.

Your desire to be fully informed regarding the death of your son, Private First Class Henry E. Zahradnik, Army serial number 32 605 630, Corps of Engineers, is most understandable. The original casualty message submitted by the Commanding General of the European Theater of Operations stated only that he was killed in action 10 October 1944 in France. Additional records now available confirm this report and indicate that on 10 October 1944 he was participating with other members of his organization in unloading and fusing antitank mines from a two and one-half ton Army truck during a mine-laying operation near Ajoncourt, France. Due to either an enemy mortar or artillery shell, defective fuses, or the dropping of a fused mine, the mines on the truck on which he was working exploded, causing approximately fifteen-hundred other mines in the vicinity to detonate. Your son was one of forty-seven casualties which resulted from the ensuing chain of explosions which followed.

The Quartermaster General of the Marmy, Washington 25, D. C., has jurisdiction over matters pertaining to the burial and personal effects of our military personnel who, die overseas. A copy of your letter has accordingly been forwarded to that officer for necessary action.




