This is a supplement to the information recently provided to you by a member of my staff, Mrs. Liz Tate, concerning the recovery and identification of remains for your brother, Private First Class Jerome C. Deneen, 36227925.

As Mrs. Tate informed you, on September 17, 2000, personnel at the U.S. Army Memorial Affairs Activity-Europe were notified of the discovery of remains in the Horsehoe Woods, located near Corny, France. A civilian group, Thanks GI Association, during clearing operations, discovered the remains. The group turned over remains and an identification tag bearing the inscription "Jerome Deneen, 36227925, T-42, Mike Deneen, Black Earth Wis". A Search and Recovery Team went to the site, completed an excavation and recovered additional portions of remains and artifacts. The remains were transported to the U.S. Army Central Identification Laboratory, Hawaii (CILHI), where they were processed for identification.

On May 14, 2001, we were informed by the CILHI that the identification processing had been completed and the remains have been positively identified as the remains of Private Deneen. As Mrs. Tate advised you, the next step in the process is for a representative from this office to meet with you to provide to you a briefing which details how your brother's remains were recovered and identified and assist you with burial arrangements. At that meeting, the representative will provide you a copy of the identification case file, which contains all of the above information.

**1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

a. On 17 Sept 2000 the United States Army Memorial Affairs Activity - Europe (USAMAA-E) was notified of the discovery of remains in the Horseshoe Woods, located near Corny, France. The Thanks GI Association discovered the remains during clearing operations conducted in the area commonly referred to as the Horseshoe Woods. The remains were reported to be exposed in-situ during clearing operations conducted by the Thanks GI Association on 17 September 2000.

b. This area was the scene of intense fighting from 8-11 September 1944 between U.S. forces and German forces. U.S. forces were attempting to establish a bridgehead from the city of Dornot, France across the Moselle River. Forces were deployed from Dornot, France across the Moselle River to the Horseshoe Woods located between the villages of Corny, France and Jouy-aux-Arches. The forces were deployed from 8-10 September 1944 and withdrawn on the night of 10-11 September 1944.

c. On 17 Sept 2000 the Thanks GI Association turned over an identification tag bearing the inscription "JEROME DENEEN, 36227925, T-42, MIKE DENEEN, BLACK EARTH WIS" and several artifacts pertaining to military clothing and equipment. The Thanks GI Association recovered these artifacts from the excavation site. The items were inventoried and documented on a DD Form 4137, (Evidence/Property Custody Document). (Enclosure 1, 1A, 1B)

d. USAMAA-E deployed personnel and equipment to Corny, France on 17 September 2000 to coordinate the transfer of remains from local French officials to U.S. government control. Members of the Thanks GI Association, at 10 rue De la Moselle, 57680 Corny-sur-MOSELLE, met the team. The Thanks GI Association took the team to the excavation site located in the area referred to as the Horseshoe Woods located between the villages of Corny, France and Jouy-aux-Arches, France. Upon arrival at the site, the team observed the incomplete excavation of skeletal remains. The skeletal remains were

in-situ on top of a rain poncho in 15 cm of water. The remains were exposed at a depth of 65 cm.

e. The team coordinated with the Corny, France Mayors office for permission to complete the excavation and contacted the French Gendarmerie to coordinate the removal and transfer of the remains and artifacts from the incident site to U.S. government control. The remains are believed to be associated with PFC Jerome C. Deneen, service number 36227925. He was a member of Co E, 11<sup>th</sup> Inf. Regt, 5<sup>th</sup> Inf, Div. According to official reports he was killed in action by shell shrapnel while establishing a bridgehead across the Moselle River, near Dornot, France on 8 September 1944. The Horseshoe woods are located directly across from Dornot, France between the villages of Corny, France and Jouy-aux-Arches. (Enclosure 2, 2A)

## **2. PROJECT LOCATION:**

a. LEGAL LOCATION: HorseShoe Woods, located between the villages of Corny, France and Jouy-aux-Arches. National Road N-57 runs north and south and is west of the site on the East Side of the Moselle River. (Enclosure 3, 3A)

b. GRID COORDINATES: N49°04.918 E06°06.901 , 116 meters elevation. The team used a Global Positioning System (GPS) instrument tracking 7 Satellites.

c. MAP NAME: Rand McNally – International Series, France, 1:200,000 (Enclosure 4)

## **3. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT AREA:**

a. The project area is located between the villages of Corny, France and Jouy-aux-Arches. The site is located in dense woods located east of the Moselle River and west national road N-57. The area is referred to as the Horseshoe Woods and was the scene of intense fighting from 8-11 September 1944. Numerous excavations were observed in the project area. These excavations consisted of rectangular excavations dug to an average depth of 65cm to 100 cm.

## **4. FIELD METHODS:**

a. The search and recovery team established on 2-x-3 meter grid system over the excavation site for mapping purposes. The team set up a transit system for measuring site dimensions and artifact provenience. A dry screening station was established for screening operations. All previously excavated soil was screened for artifacts and human

remains yielding negative results. Remains and identification media were recovered from a depth of 45cm to 65 cm. All remains artifacts and identification media were documented during the recovery process. A chain of custody was completed for each individual item recovered. The site was excavated to sterile soil at a depth of 85 cm, 70 cm from ground level to water level and 15 cm below water level. The 2-x-3 meter grid was excavated to a depth of 85cm. Sterile soil was reached in all areas of the 2-x-3 meter grid.

(Enclosure 5)

b. The topsoil was black loam to a depth of at a depth of 30cm. Light tan clay soil was observed at a depth of 30-cm to 55-cm. The clay cap turned to a layer of light tan sand from a depth of 55cm to 85cm. The bottom of the excavated area was composed of light tan sand. Soil was removed to a depth of 85cm.

c. Shovels, picks and trowels were used. The team established a dry screening stations five meters from the excavation site. Sifting operations were conducted for wet and dry soil.

#### **5. EXCAVATION FINDINGS:**

a. Human remains consisting of one intact skeleton were recovered from the excavation site. The skeletal remains were exposed in-situ, lying on the right side from the cranial vault to the bottom of the left foot. In addition to human remains, several artifacts were recovered pertaining to portions of military gear and personal effects. See DA Form 4137 (Evidence/Property Custody Document) for additional information relating to a complete list of human remains and artifacts recovered from the site. These items will be forwarded to United States Army Central Identification Lab for processing. (Enclosure 6, 6A, 6B)

b. On 17 September 2000, USAMAA-E, IAW French Law, turned the recovered human remains and artifacts over to the French Gendarmerie, of Corny, France. This was done in accordance with French Law. A chain of custody document was completed to document the turn over. The remains BTB an American serviceman were turned over to USAMAA-E on 19 September 2000 for identification.

c. The remains and evidence were placed on medical hold and released to the United States Army Memorial Affairs Activity – Europe for onward movement to USA CILHI. (Enclosure 7)

#### **6. CONCLUSION RECOMENDATIONS:**

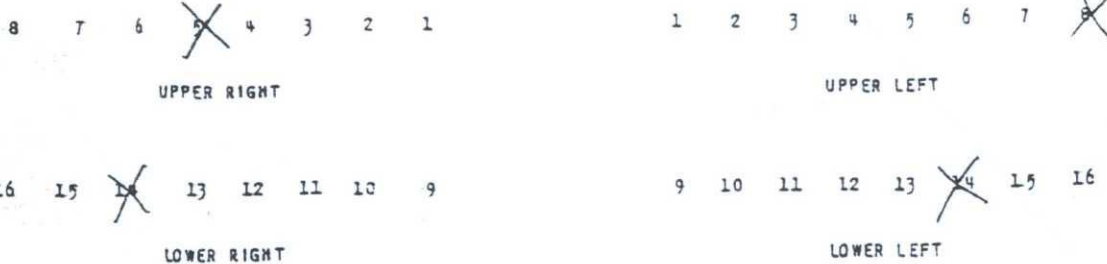

Efforts to effect association with unidentified recoveries from the area, now interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries, have also proven negative. The lack of specific information regarding the death or burial, limited search in most instances to general localities, however, documents on file in this Office and Office of the Quartermaster General substantiate the fact that numerous investigations covering the entire department of Moselle have been conducted in the course of search operations for all losses, both recovered and unrecovered. I am forwarding to you a DNA family reference specimen kit for use in the possible identification of remains for your brother, Private First Class Jerome C. Deneen, 36227925.

Please complete the enclosed forms with as much information as you can and return with the blood specimens. Be sure to sign the consent form.

For the specimens, the laboratory requires the two Vacutainers filled with approximately 14 milliliters of your blood. Please indicate your name and SSN on each tube. Place the tubes in the plastic shipping containers and screw the tops down. Keep the blood refrigerated until you are ready to send it to the laboratory. When ready to ship, place the chemical ice in your freezer overnight. Freeze only the chemical ice and not the blood tubes. Place the tubes in the opposite end of the shipping box with the absorbent material and seal. Place this box in the larger box and seal it. This can then be returned to the laboratory via overnight express mail or commercial carrier. These shipping containers meet all postal and commercial carrier standards for sending of blood products. 

SYNOPSIS: The casualties listed on attached roster are reported by official records as Missing in Action or Killed in Action during ground or air operations in the department of Moselle, France, from the period 5 September 1944 to 16 March 1945. Extensive area searches as well as individual investigation have to date failed to furnish information as to the ultimate disposition of their remains. Efforts to effect association with unidentified recoveries from the area, now interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries, have also proven negative. The lack of specific information regarding the death or burial, limited search in most instances to general localities, however, documents on file in this Office and Office of The Quartermaster General substantiate the fact that numerous investigations covering the entire department of Moselle have been conducted in the course of search operations for all losses, both recovered and unrecovered. The terrain of the Moselle department, for the most part, consists of farm, pasture and forested areas which has been under constant cultivation and supervision by farmers and forest guards, since the cessation of hostilities, thus the possibility of undiscovered graves is remote. It can therefore be concluded that the remains of the deceased in question were reduced by battle action to a state which precludes recovery or identification. The absence of specific information concerning their deaths, the failure of Field Investigations to provide

evidence and the lack of association with recovered unknowns would tend to substantiate these conclusions. It is recommended that the remains of the individuals listed in these Board Proceedings be considered Non-Recoverable under the provisions of paragraph 3b, Letter, Office of The Quartermaster General, file QMGMP 293, Subject: Processing Board Findings of Non-Recoverability Return of World War II Dead Program, dated 25 March 1949.




