Dear Mr. Piltzecker:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. The Quartermester General of the Army has been entrusted with this secred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed pemphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and 'Aserican Cometeries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of him according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pemphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part III of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

. If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

The records of this office disclose that his remains are interred in the U.S. Military Cemetery Margraten, Holland, plot JJ, row 11, grave 261. You may be assured that the identification and interment have been accomplished with fitting dignity and solemnity.

This cemetery is located ten miles west of Aachen, Germany, and is under the constant care and supervision of United States military personnel.

Acknowledgment is made of your letter concerning your son, the late Technician Fifth Grade Charles H. Piltzecker.

The official report of interment received in this office reveals that the remains of your son are interred in the U. S. Military Cemetery, Margraten, Holland, Flot JJ, Row 11. Grave 261. With reference to other larger cities the approximate location of Margraten, is twelve miles northwest of Aachen, Germany and eight miles southeast of Maastricht. Holland.

It is regretted to advise you that there is no provision at the present time whereby the War Department can furnish photographs of individual graves of our deceased military personnel outside of the United States, or the cemeteries in which the deceased military personnel are interred.

Please accept my sincere sympathy in the loss of your son.
