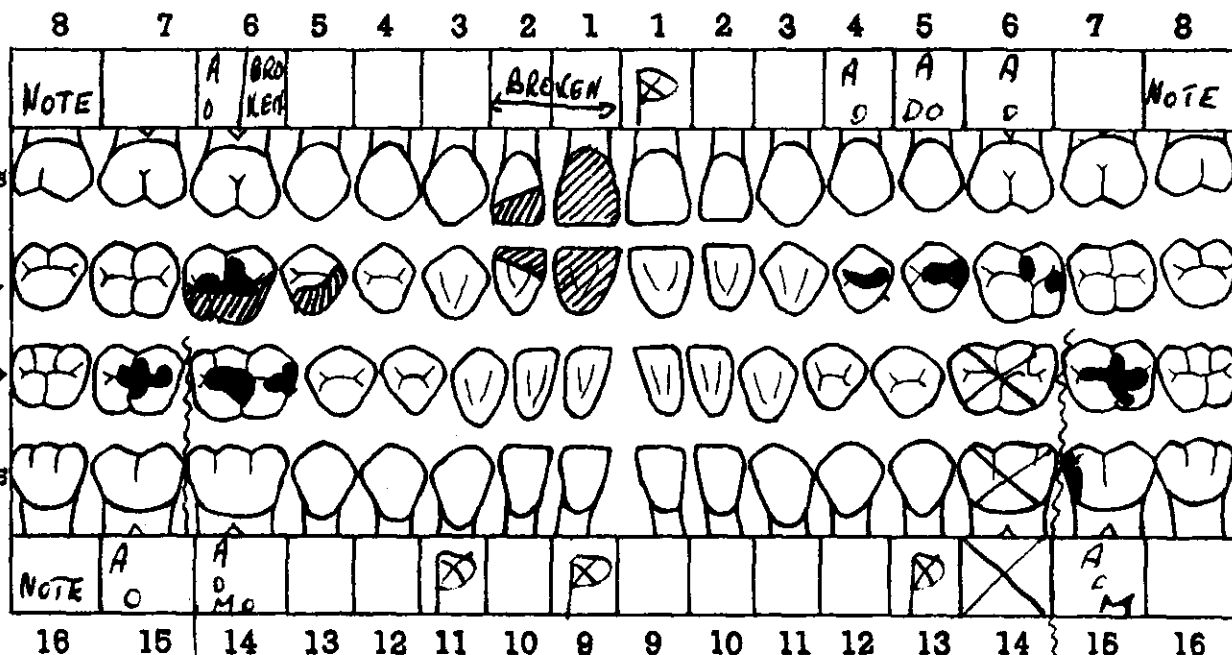

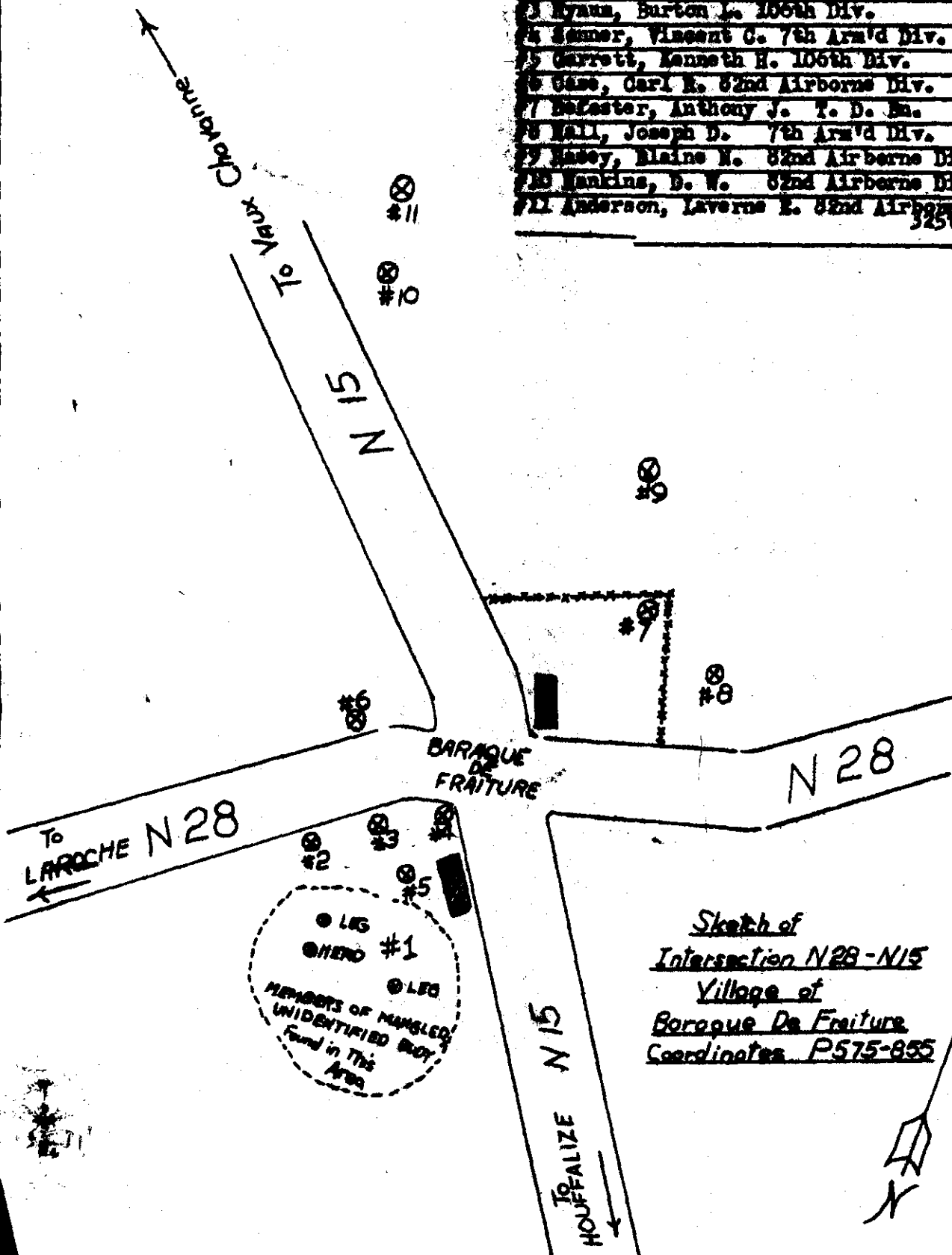

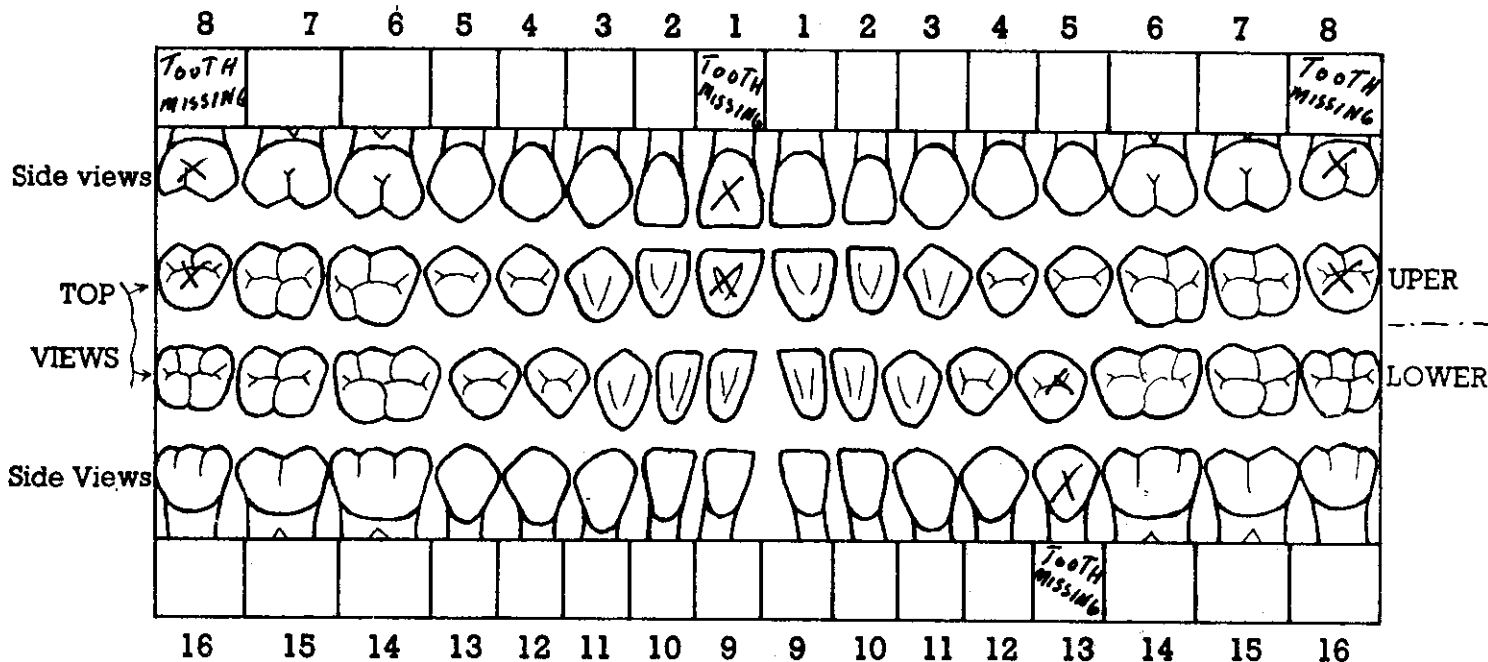

1. Reference is made to Report of Burial for Unknown X-382, interred in U.S. Military Cemetery at Henri Chapelle, Belgium, Plot QQQ, Row 7, Grave 132. Estimated date of death is 15 November 1944.

2. It is noted on chart submitted with Report of Burial that remains were found at intersection of N-28 and N-15, Village of Baraque De Fraiture, Co-ordinates P 575-855. It is also noted on the chart that there were bodies of deceased found in that area from the 82nd Airborne Div., 325th Infantry; 589th F.A., 106th Division; 7th Armored Division and a T.D. Bn.
