NARRATIVE ON VOSSENACK, GERMANY CASE

On 10 April 1947 we proceeded to the Hurtgen Forest, (Section Raffelsbrand) to disinter the remains of an American deceased found by forester HEINRICH REAUJEAN, Breinig # 25.

HEINRICH BEAUJEAN found the remains while checking a team of wood cutters working in that area.

Remains consisted of just a few bones, some being in a burnt condition along with a few G.I. equipment. It is possible that the deceased was hit by artillery fire.

No I.D.-tags or P.E. of the deceased were found.




