MARRATIVE ON GROSSHAU, GERMANY CASE

On the 23 April 1947 an investigation team proceeded to the Hurtgen-Forest to locate and disinter the remains of an unburied American soldier. The information was received from Siegfried Glassen, Grosshau, Hauptstrasse 24.

This investigation team recovered the remains lying on the surface of the ground. The remains consisted of dry bones and G.I. equipment.

The deceased is believed to be killed by Artillery, since the woods around the place of death are shattered by Artillery. The month of death seems to be December 1944 when the heaviest fighting took place in the Eurtgen-Forest.

No Identification tags could be found on the remains.




