CERTIFICATE OF UNIDENTIFIABILITY OF REMAINS

1. The records pertaining to Unknown X-83, Plot E, Row 9, Grave 223, USMC Neuville-en-Condroz, Belgium have been reviewed in accordance with par 159, SR 830-110-5, DA, dated 3 March 1949, and it is the opinion of the Board of Review, appointed by par 2, SO No. 108, this headquarters, dated 29 August 1950, that sufficient evidence is not available to establish the identity of the deceased concerned, and it is recommended these remains be classified as unidentifiable.

CASE HISTORY

UNKNOWN X-83

UNIDENTIFIABLE

USMC NEUVILLE, BELGIUM  
(E-9-223)

Unknown X-83 and the remains of 2/Lt Earl L. TOWNSEND, O-826568, were washed ashore at Wenduine, Belgium, on 1 May 1945. ID tag was found on the body of 2/Lt Townsend, the pilot of P-47 aircraft #44-21136 which was reported missing on 14 March 1945.

Report of Investigation disclosed that Unknown X-83 was clothed in gray wool trousers, dark brown low-cut shoes, black wool socks, and garters marked "Boston Garters". It is noted the above type clothing would indicate X-83 was possibly a US Naval or Merchant Marine casualty. However, the nationality of the subject Unknown was not definitely established.

Reprocessing of Unknown X-83 by the anthropologist on 13 September 1950 revealed the following identifying media:

- a. Deceased had complete upper and lower dentures.
- b. Age was estimated as approximately 29 years.
- c. Height was determined to be 5'6 3/8".

In view of the fact that the dental information submitted for Unknown X-83 was compared with available dental records of both US Navy and Army deceased reported in the Belgian coastal area with negative results, it is recommended the subject Unknown be classified as UNIDENTIFIABLE.

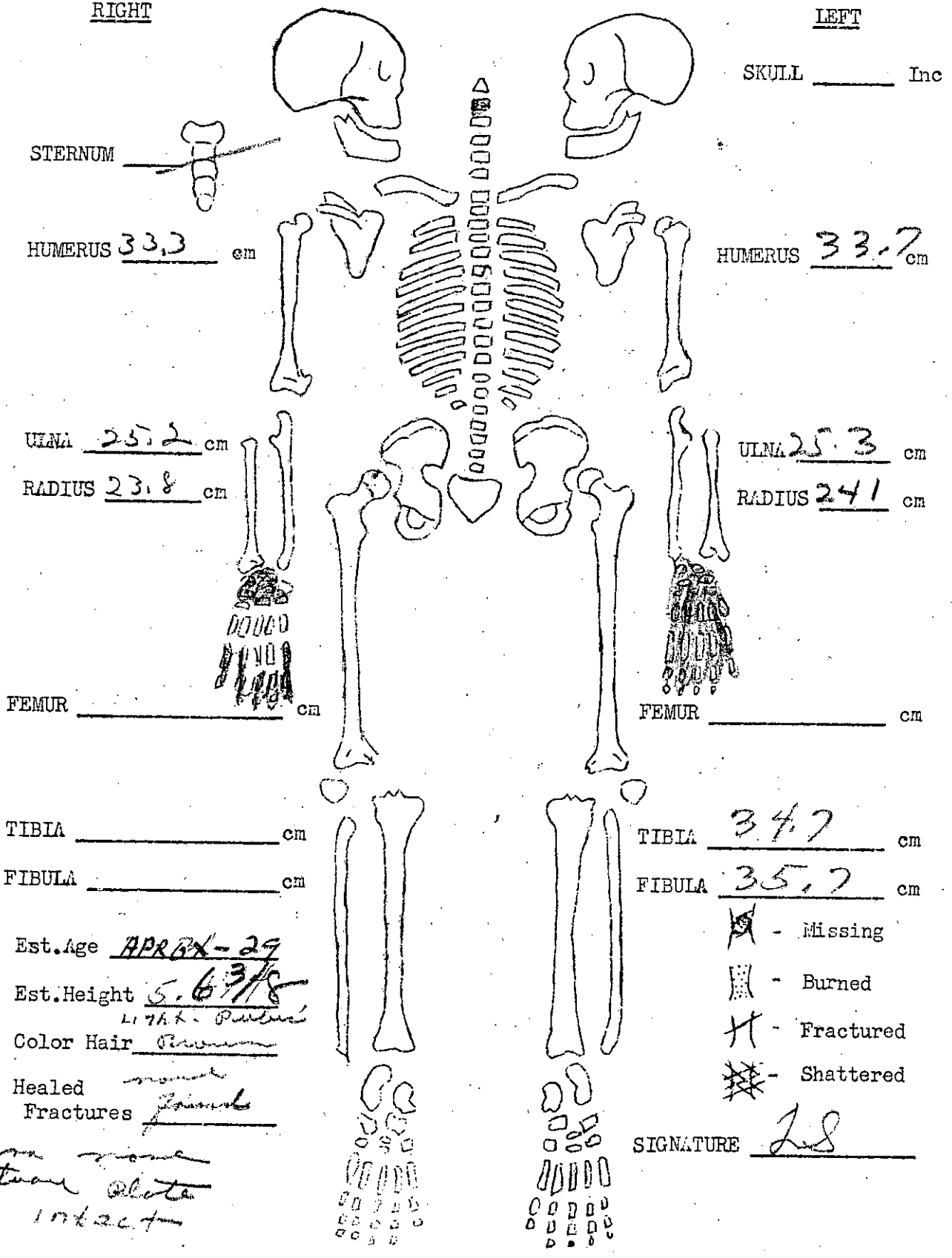

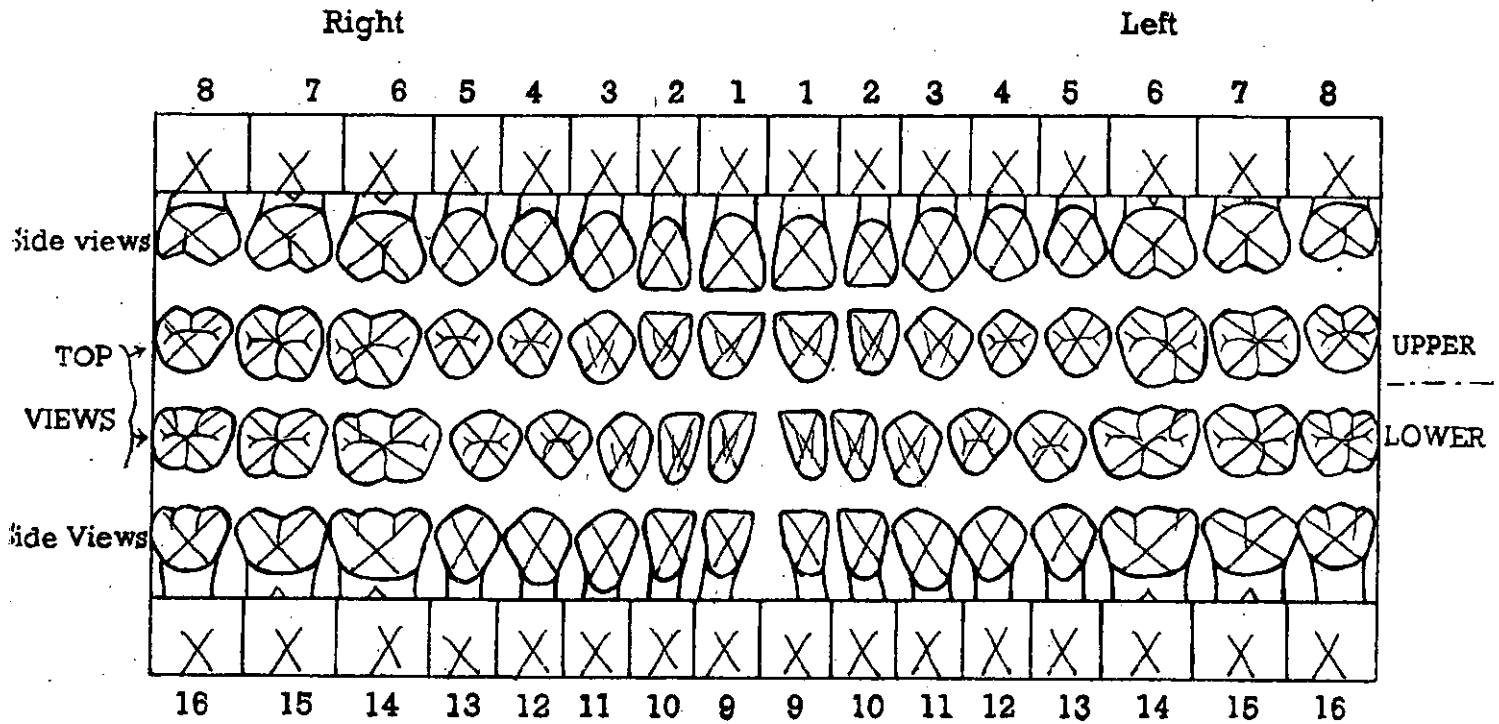

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. There is articulation between skull and vertebral column. Teeth articulate with skull, however, it appears that the remains regarding (skull) at one time had upper and lower dentures, upon processing the dentures were not recovered. Closure of skull sutures are abnormal. Race estimated as - white.



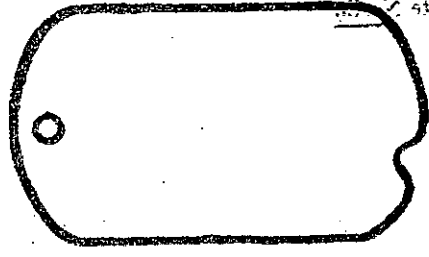
