U.S. Military Cemetery Luynea

At the time X-75 was recovered from the isolated cemetery at Logoubran Cemetery, Toulon, it was reported that the case designated as X-75 washed ashore, approximately 11 Sept 44.

The remains were found to consist of about 10 pounds of dirt, ashes, and parachute. Upon reprocessing it was found that no human remains were present.

There were no clues as to the crew from which the case X-75 was recovered, which could throw light on why case X-75 was originally interred in the isolated cemetery as a body. ince no human remains are present, case X-75 is eliminated.

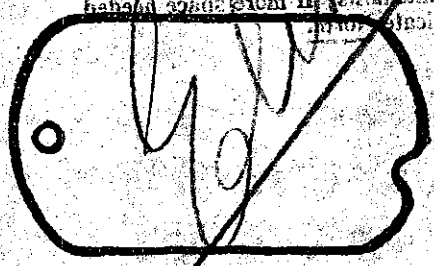

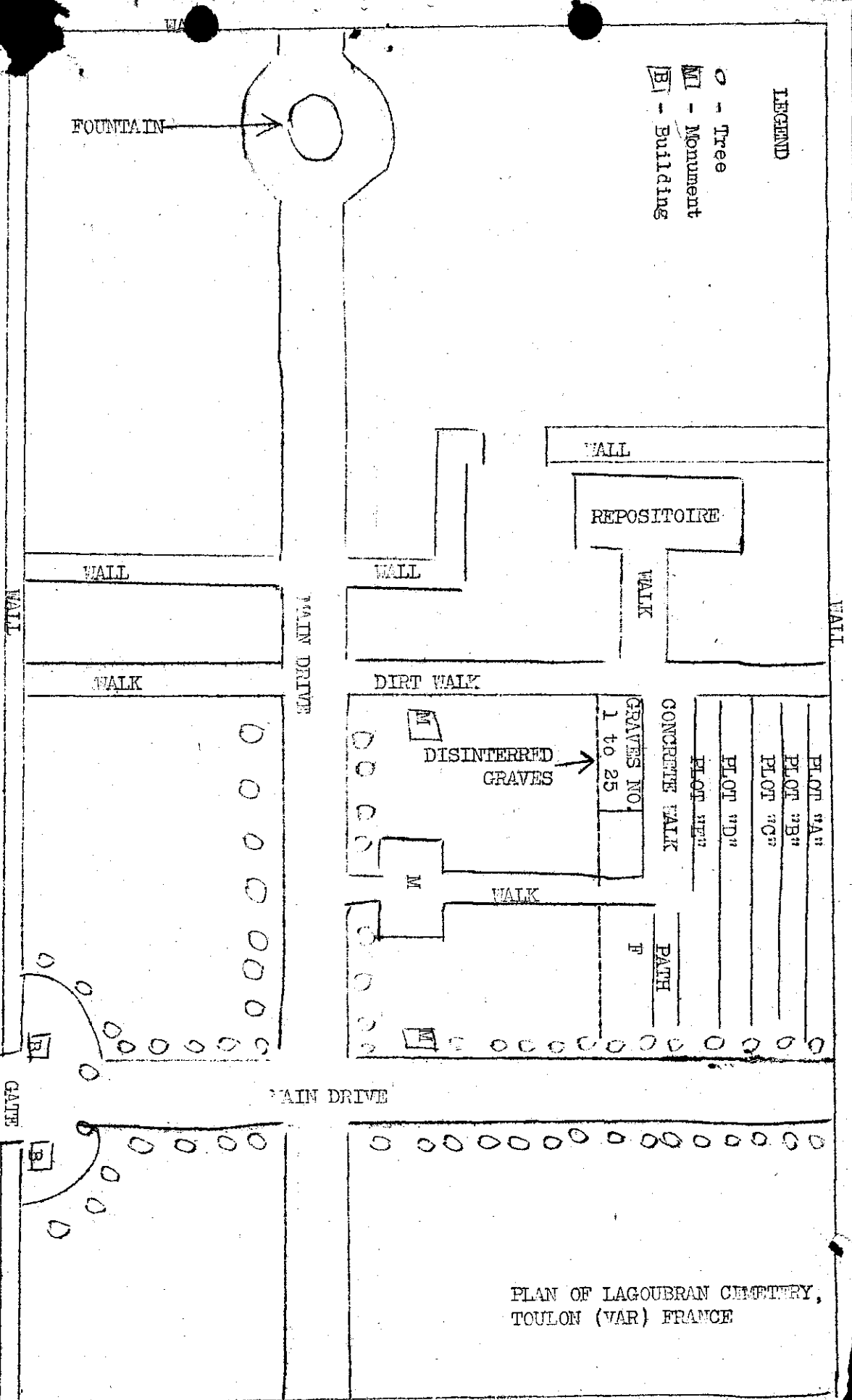

1. According to Navy Department records Ernest George GUSTARD, 922 00 72, S1c, USNR, died aboard the USS SHER (AM-112) on 10 September 1944. He received a compound fracture of the knee, multiple wounds of the head and face, and possible other internal injuries from being thrown against a hedge hog rack when the ship hit a mine. The remains were sent to Toulon, France, and according to Navy records, buried in Lagoubran Cimetiere, Section 4, Trench 1, Grave 21, at Toulon, France, on 12 September 1944.

2. Unknown X-75, US Military Cemetery, Luynes, France, shows that body disinterred from Lagoubran Cimetiere, Section 4, Trench 1, Grave 21, at Toulon, France, was a body that washed ashore and was buried on 11 September 1944. It consisted of about 10 pounds of burial ashes, parachute dirt, etc, in a small coffin.

3. Unknown X-78, American Military Cemetery, Luynes, France, shows that body was disinterred from Grave 22, Section 4, Trench 1, Lagoubran Cimetiere, at Toulon, France. Cemetery records the name as Gustard, from US Navy, and states that an American Naval Officer whose name is not available gave this information. Body was intact, showed injuries of mouth and legs, with teeth gone. A bandage was found around the face. Date of burial was 12 September 1944. Fingerprints and tooth chart were impossible to obtain.

4. In view of the fact that Ernest George GUSTARD was interred on 12 September 1944, the same date as Unknown X-78, and the description of the condition of Gustard's injuries were exactly the condition of X-78, the Navy Department accepts the identity of the remains now buried in Grave 430, Row 12, Plot G, US Military Cemetery, Luynes, France, as Ernest George GUSTARD, S1c, USNR, 922 00 72.
