







INSTRUCTIONS:

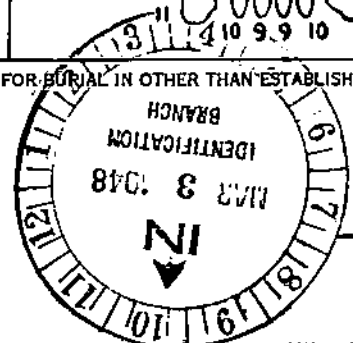

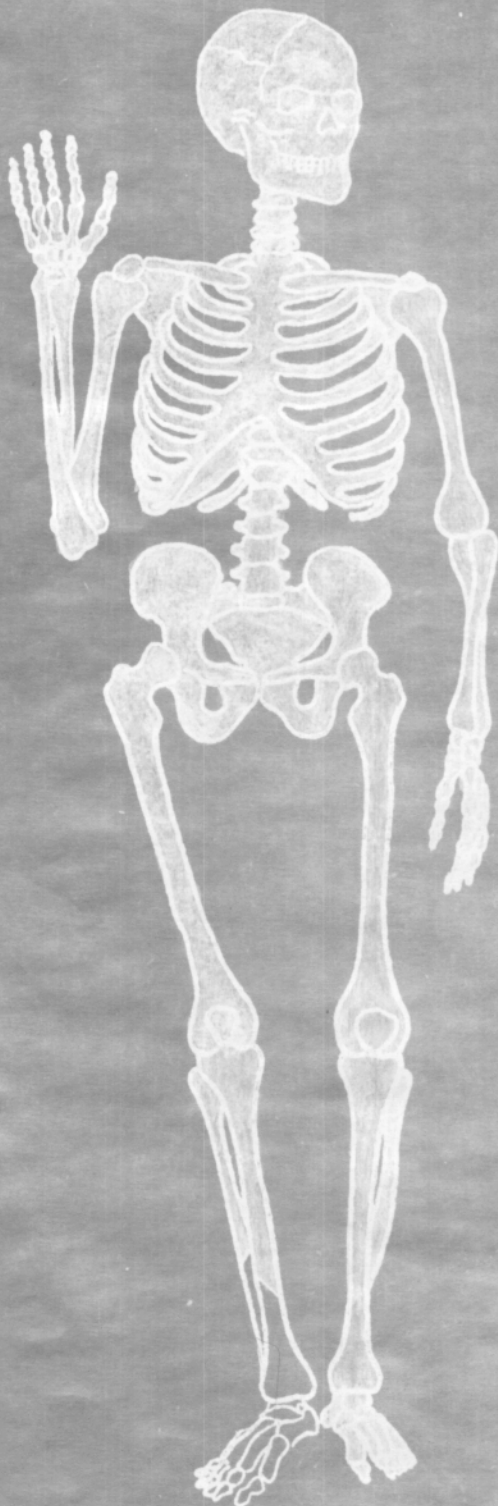
REMARKS: Remains consist of lower half of the tibia and fibula and a complete right foot. Shoe found on the foot indicated the shoe size as 7-E.
