Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of Oct. 11. I cannot be sure who was wearing my leggings at the time mentioned. My outfit was Co. M-3rd Bn of the 329th Infantry. We were machine gunners and we usually had a squad of riflemen with us from either I, K, or L Co. At night when conditions were favorable we would pull our shoes and leggings off. There could have been a mix up at any time.

There were approximately seven of us in a german dug out around the date mentioned. There was a Smit and his radioman, myself, and four men from my squad. I heard the Lt. was killed the next day from a direct hit and a couple of the replacements were wounded. One replacements name was pronounced Hatcher.
