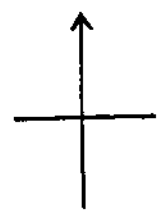

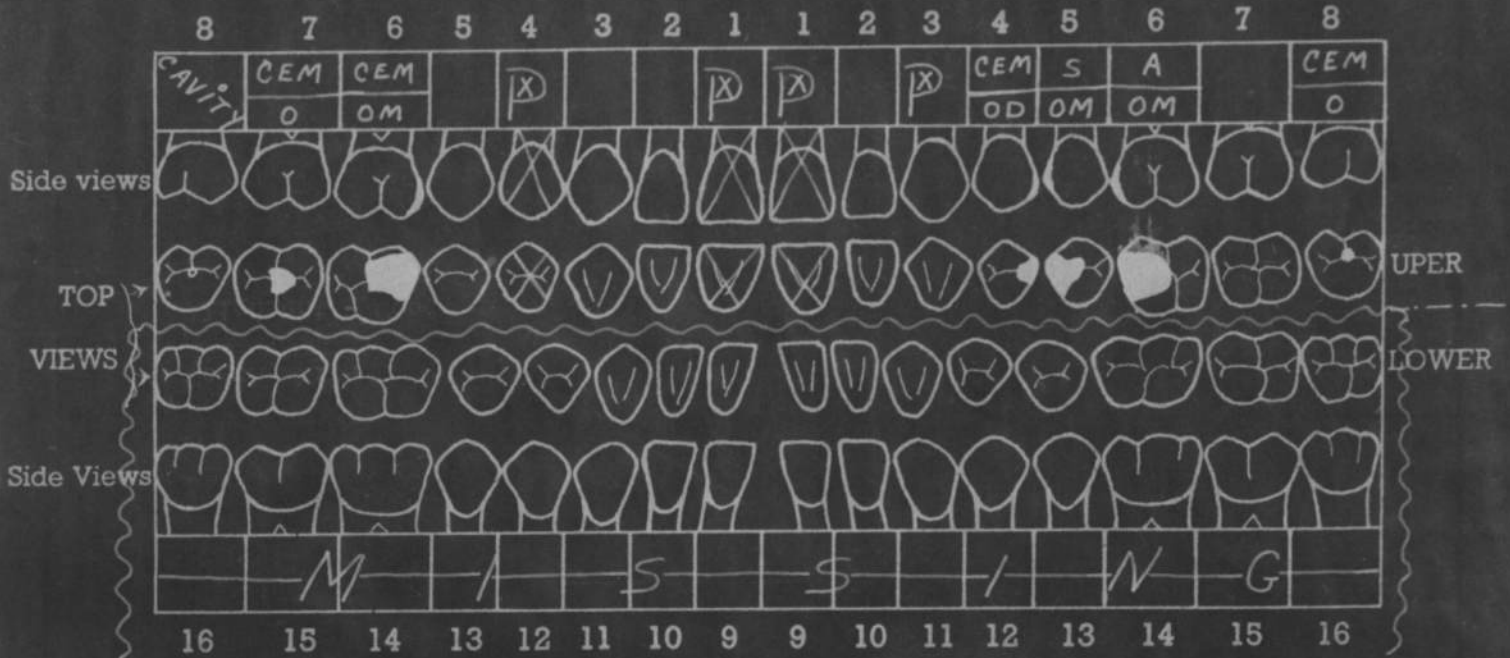

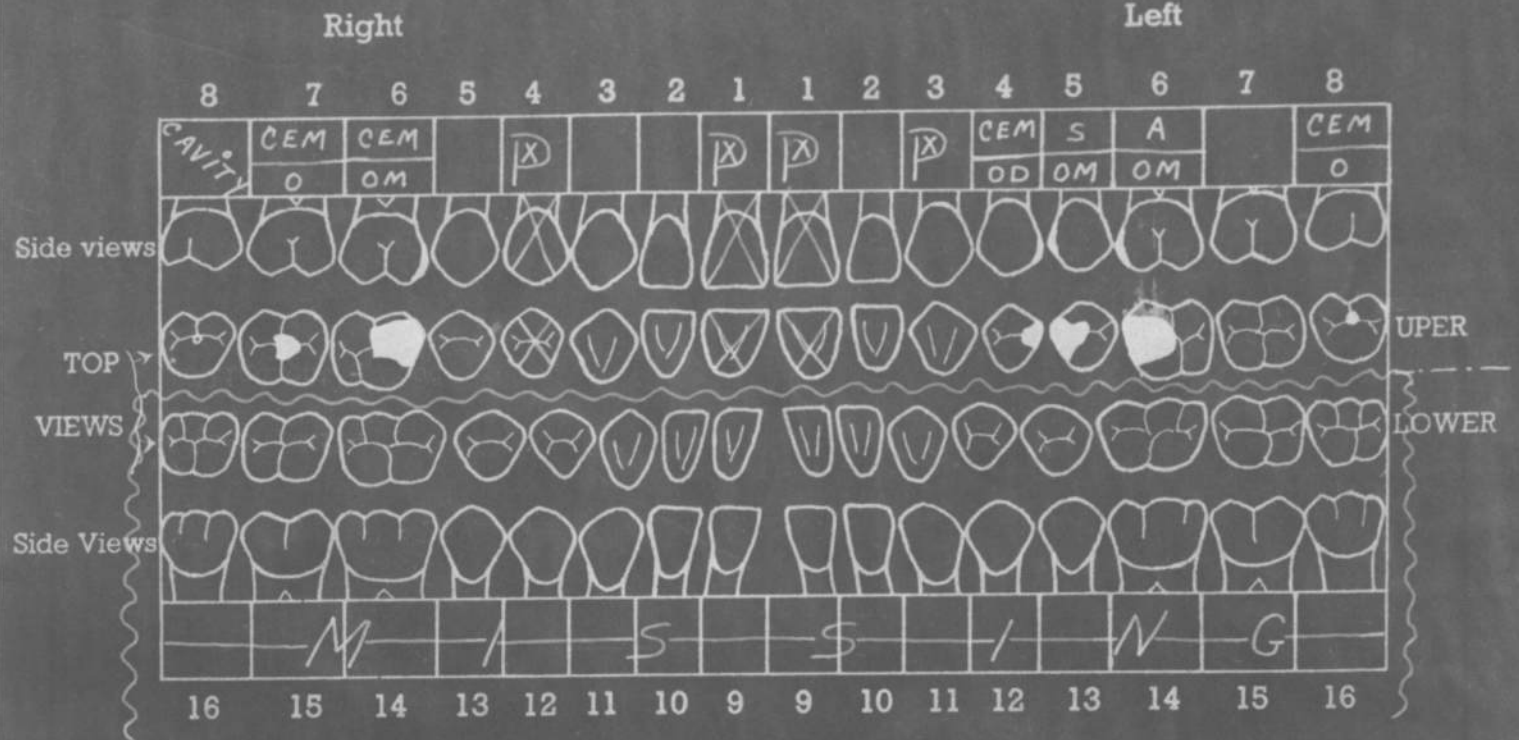

1. There are inclosed temporary reports of interment for Unknowns X-169 and X-170, USMC St Laurent. As noted on reports of interment, these unknowns were discovered during the processing of identified decedents from St Laurent.

2. Board of Review, this headquarters, has been unable to associate either unknown with another burial at St Laurent, and therefore has directed that the additional remains recovered in each case be designated as an unidentified deceased.

3. Tooth charts and blackout charts have been attached to report of interment where applicable.

4. It is requested that this headquarters be advised disposition to be made of these remains, presently being held in morgue at USMC St Laurent.
