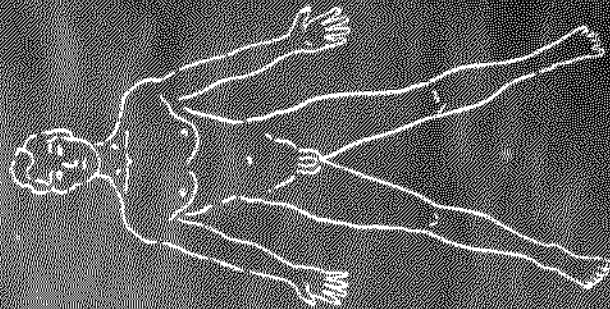

I certify that I have personally viewed the remains of subject deceased and all resulting information has been recorded to the best of my knowledge.

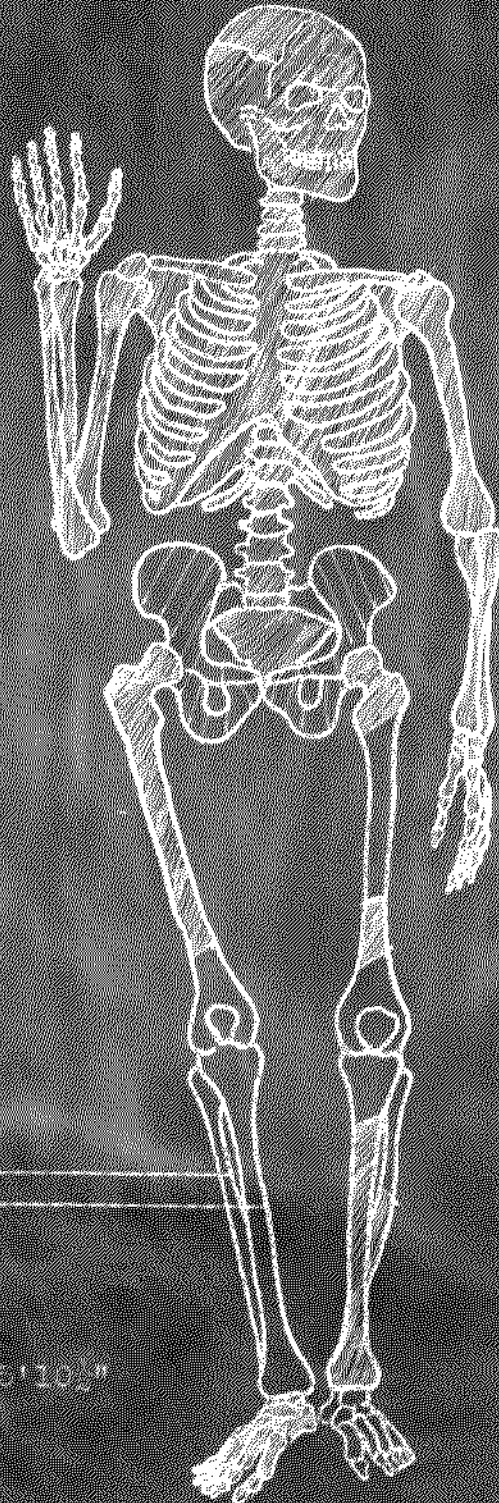
