1. The Army Effects Bureau has received one bracelet marked as a personal effects of Unknown decedent buried in St. Laurent Sur Mer Cemetery; Point of Coordination "675-896". There is inclosed original Graves Registration label and pertinent overseas inventory of effects dated 23 July 1944, signed by Ove H. Nielsen, 1/Lt, QMC, 2nd Infantry Division.

2. Bureau examination of the bracelet failed to reveal any initials or engraving which would aid in the establishing of identity of Unknown decedent.

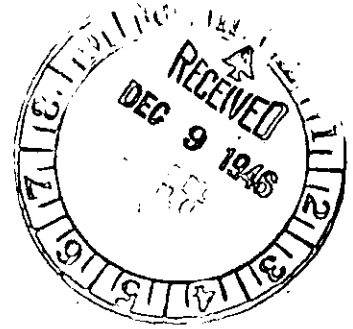
