INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER MARKINGS ON DENTAL CHART

1. Give all information and description on dental chart as nearly correct as the condition of the body will allow. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridgework, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.

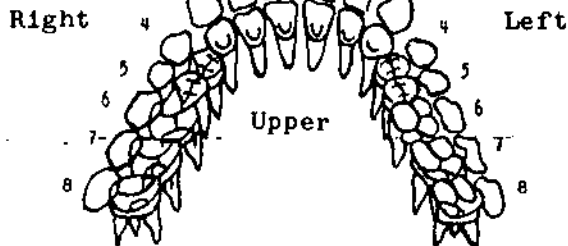
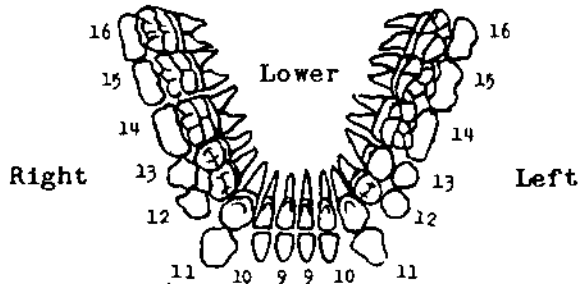

Case Unknown X-83 was processed and found to contain a mass of three (3) men. Separation was accomplished as only bones of the pelvic and femoral region of all three men existed with the exception of a few miscellaneous tarsals and portions of a clavicle, ribs and vertebrae.

To qualify separation, all the major bones were found still articulated.

Case Unknown X-83 has been changed to Unknown X-83 A, B, and C.

All the clothing was found common among the debris.

Fluoroscopic Examination of the clothing, debris, and remains: negative. The clothing and debris are reburied with case Unknown X-83 A.

No height determination was possible as all major bones are fractured or missing.

Burial Report was found. No GRS tag was found-

As no positive identifying clues were found case remains "UNKNOWN".
