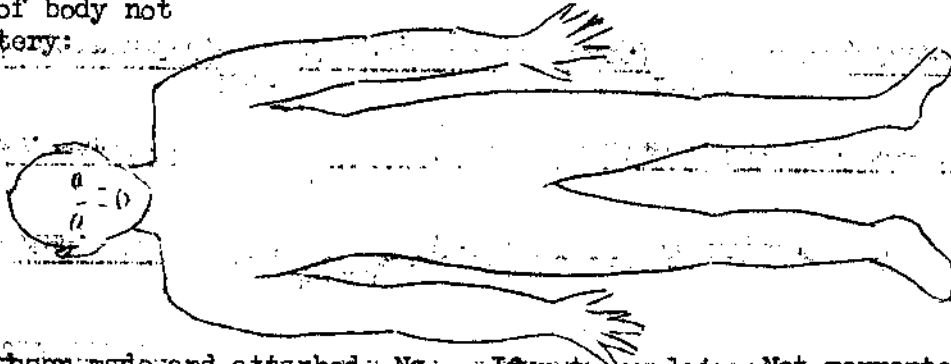

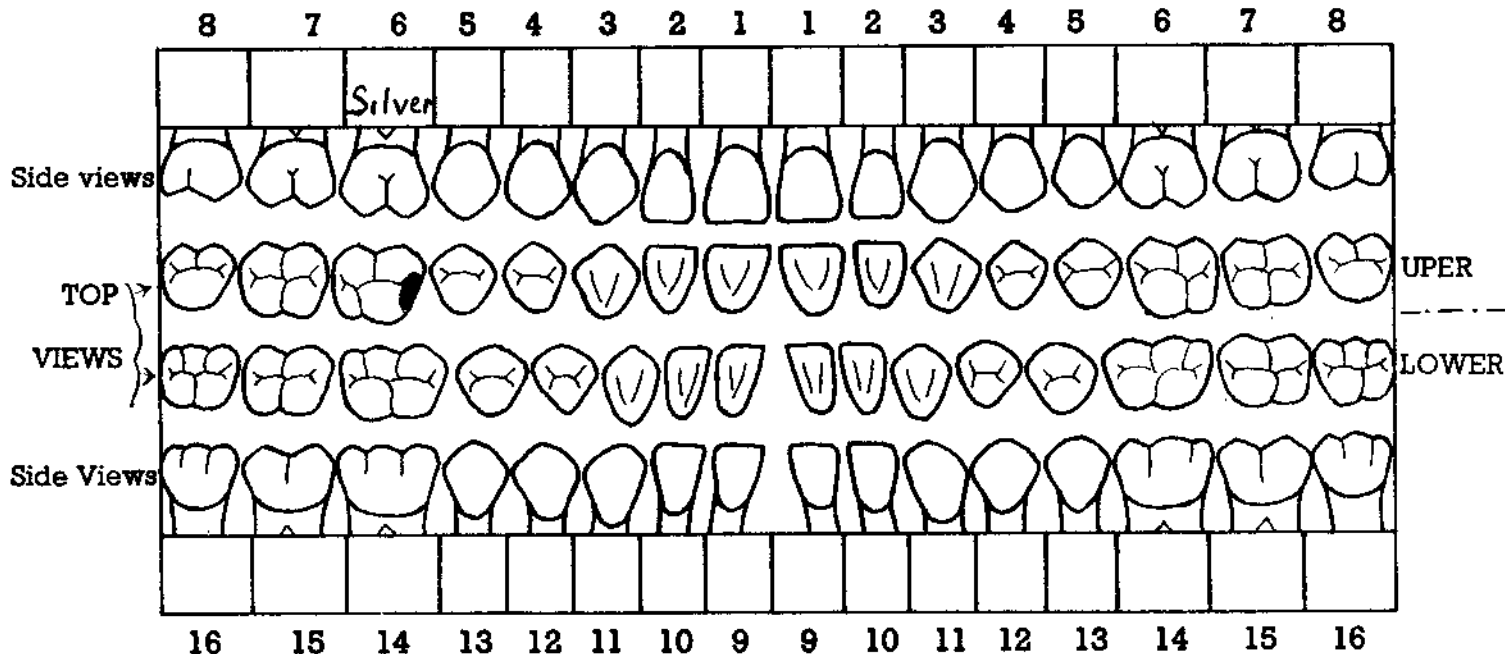

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. 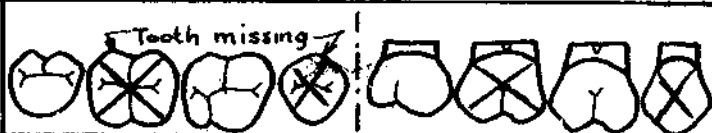

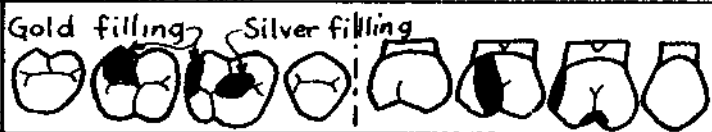

STREET, 34950249 but the fingerprints on Report of Burial do not correspond with those of Pfc Street. Several attempts have been made to identify this Unknown through the use of fingerprints without results. Tooth chart and physical characteristics of L-1067 have been compared against unresolved casualties in the area from which these remains were recovered also without results. In view of this these remains are being declared UNIDENTIFIABLE.
