CASE HISTORY

Unknown X-414

USMC St Avoird, France

Remains of Unknown X-414 were disinterred from the Cemetery at Atzendorf, Germany. Map Sheet M-52/D-92.

The only clue as to the identity of the remains is the remark on the Report of Burial stating that the deceased was a crew member of A/C #43-38110.

The remains were reprocessed by an anthropologist in an effort to obtain sufficient information to compare with dental and physical records of all casualties known to have died in the area embraced by Map Sheet M-52. The estimated height, weight and color of hair was determined also a tooth chart was accomplished for the teeth found with the remains. It was found that an association by comparison of age, weight and color of hair, was possible, however, the association could not be supported by a dental records comparison nor sufficient cumulative evidence. It was further noted, while investigating this case, that the cemetery at Atzendorf received direct bomb hits causing several of the burial containers to be exposed, necessitating reburial. It appears that, during the reburial of the remains, there was a disregard for the original cemetery records. It is also possible that there are remains of U.S. casualties in graves that have not been exhumed, as the cemetery records contain names of American deceased that have not been associated with any of the recovered remains.

The cemetery at Atzendorf, Germany, is in the Russian occupied Zone.

In view of the evidence presented herein, it is recommended that remains designated Unknown X-414, St Avoird, be declared Unidentifiable.

Exhumation Order ( 3483

Cases X-84, X-97, X-187, X-400 and X-414 have been reprocessed simultaneously with results as follows:

1. X-187 is not contradictory for OLTMAN but there are no teeth. The estimated age is 28-30, estimated height 6-1 1/2, estimated weight 175-200. Each factor is in excellent agreement with 371 for OLTMAN.

2. X-400 is not contradictory for KOCH but no teeth are present. The estimated age is 19-20, estimated height 5-10 1/8, estimated weight 130-150. Each of these factors is in excellent agreement with 371 for KOCH.

3. There are some features of X-414 which agree for MISTROT but other features are in disagreement. The estimated height of 5-6 1/2 compares with 5-7 for MISTROT; the estimated weight is 135-155 which compares favorably with given weight of 131 for MISTROT; pubic hair is brown which is also favorable. The teeth have five (5) extractions in the maxilla and there are several silicate fillings which are not shown on the form 371, however, the notations on FPDIF for MISTROT indicate the exact spacings between teeth as are present in the teeth for this case. The age of this remains is estimated at 26-28 which is five to seven years older than MISTROT and there is no evidence of any fractures of either forearm.

4. Cases X-97 and X-84 cannot be associated with any of the casualties for whom Form 371 have been submitted.
