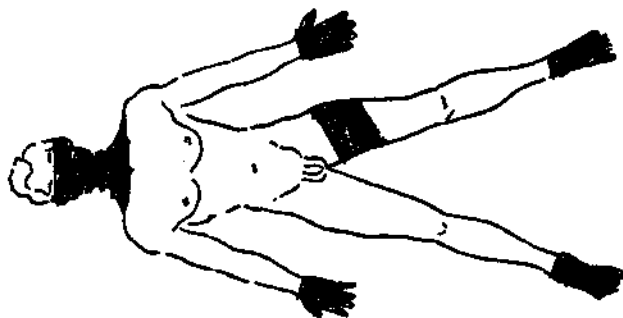



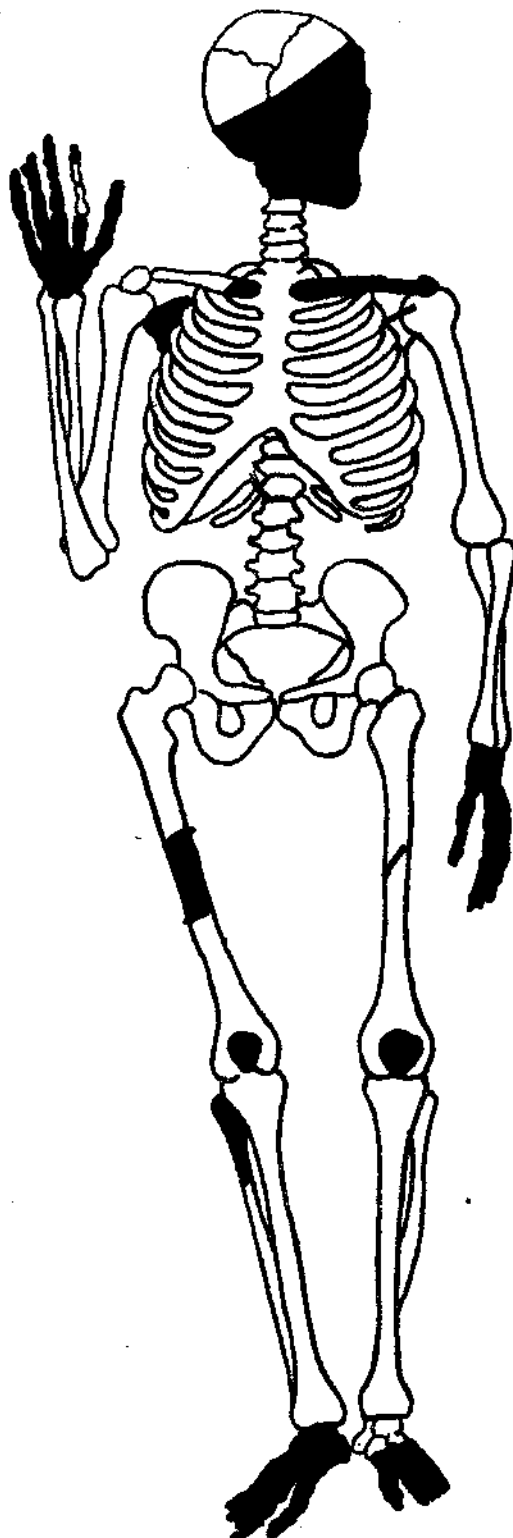
SKELETAL CHART





