This information was obtained from the cemetery files of the Vienna Central Cemetery. Spelling of names is exactly as indicated on their files. In cases where there are more than one remains indicated in a grave, the order in which they have been interred, layer by layer, has been indicated with the first listed remains being the bottom layer. Identification numbers indicated on the files have been listed hereon.

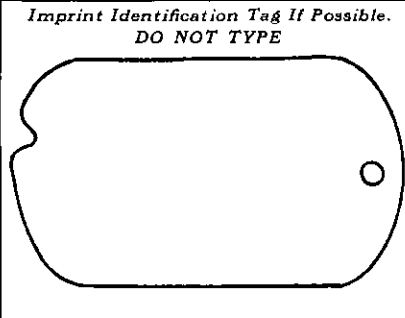

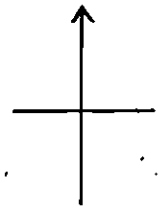
