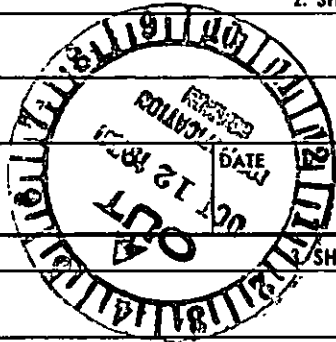

1. This headquarters is in receipt of a report of burial for an Unknown American X-80. Remains were evacuated from coordinates G843227, Sheet 160-I, 1/50,000, Atina, Italy.

2. The following named enlisted men were also evacuated from this area, Private James R. Lindsey, 34710729, Private First Class Carl A. Kopischke, 37566524, and Private John S. Kosiorek, 33680718; all formerly members of Company "A", 135th Infantry Regiment.

3. The only other information which may aid in an identification of the subject deceased, is the shoe size 11D.

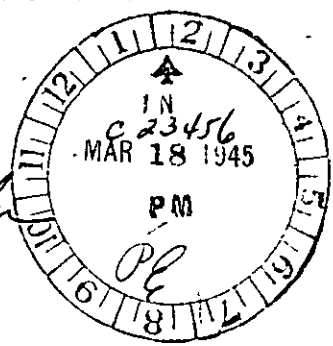
4. It is desired that the above information be used in an effort to establish the identity of subject unknown.

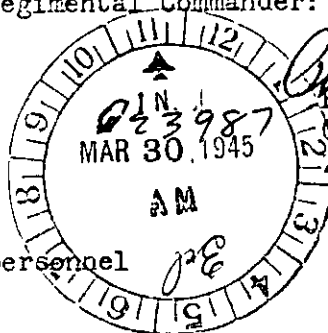

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Abramowicz, Alexander R. Pfc. 36807471 - Height 5' 8"; Weight 160 lbs; brown hair; brown eyes. The bodies of Pfc Abramowicz, T/Sgt Baumhover, Pfc. Robert H. Allen, 34731099, Co A, KIA 18 FEB 44 - body recovered from isolated grave at G-858-215; Pfc Clymer; and Pfc Roguski, all KIA by mortar shell, were left in a room of the jailhouse in Cassino, Italy for several days until New Zealander Troops relieved our unit. KIA at 857216.

Baumhover, Raymond A. T/Sgt 20701494 - Brown eyes; height 5' 10"; hair black; weight 170 lbs; shoes 10 3/4 (smooth type); leggins (cut off on top); OD uniform, combat jacket. Had net on helmet but was not wearing helmet when KIA. Wallet in pocket with pictures of family. Believed to have been wearing GI wrist watch, dog tags and had name written on leggins. See Abramowicz for circumstances of death. KIA at 857216.

Bolton, Ronald A. Pfc 34705541 - Trousers 32-21; shirt 15-33; OD hood; wore over shoes; weight 165 lbs; shoe size 8; field jacket 36 (34th Div patch on it); height 5' 8"; hair light brown. Was KIA 10 feet from jail-house in Cassino. KIA at 857216.

Cacko, Henry H. Pfc. 32595319 - Height 5' 8"; hair straight brown; complexion fair; trousers 30-33; weight 165 lbs; eyes blue; shoe size 8 1/2; shirt 14 1/2-32. Was KIA by machine gun bullet and body placed in house in Cassino. The house was knocked down next day by consistent SP fire. KIA NE edge of Cassino, Italy

Clymer, Kenneth R. Pfc 37516664 - No description available. Was new man in the company. See Abramowicz for circumstances of death. KIA at 857.216.

Cochran, Gordon W. Cpl. 20603314 - Hair brown; weight 140 lbs; height 5' 6"; jacket 34; shirt 14 1/2-32; trousers 30-31; shoes size 7; wore ring (Oran Africa 1943 inscribed on it) and one ring (Tunis inscribed on it). Cpl Cochran was KIA when a house he was in caved in due to shell fire, burying him. KIA 856.216.

Davis, C. W., Jr. Sgt. 38449964 - Blonde hair; 5' 9" in height; weight 150 lbs; (Approx); slender build; wore combat jacket, trousers, shoes. Company "C" made an attack on the Castle at Cassino. He was a scout and went over a ridge. The company heard MG fire and Davis called for help. He was KIA but no one could reach him to evacuate him. KIA at 848.212.

Feeney, John J. Pfc. 33460630 - Height 5' 5"; light bushy brown hair; white wool drawers (32); weight approximately 140 lbs; shirt 15-32; trousers 32-30; shoes size 8; jacket 34; age 27. Was KIA when a shell hit a house on edge of Cassino and the house caved in smothering occupants.

Fisher, Joseph V. Pvt. 33603551 - Dark hair; height 5' 10"; weight 150 lbs; slender build; wore combat jacket and trousers; had two teeth missing in upper front (upper 1 & 2). Was seen killed by sniper bullet when company "C" made attack on Castle at Cassino. Body lay in draw close to stream. KIA at 848212.

Gierhart, Harold A. Pvt. 35556959 - Height 5' 10"; weight 140-150 lbs; combat jacket (with dull yellow outlined 34th Div patch); artic trousers; scarf under helmet (used as hood); GI wrist watch in pocket; GI shoes & leggins; wore

OD suit under artic suit; bible; medium brown hair; 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ -32 shirt; 31-32, 33 trousers. Was standing guard in corner of a building when it was hit by an artillery shell covering him with debris. This bldg was next to jailhouse in Cassino, Italy. KIA at 857.216.

- Kennedy, Robert G. Pfc. 34520413 - shirt 15-34; trousers 34-35; shoes 11; wore large combat jacket; black hair; weight 185 lbs; height 5'11"; had "C-133" stamped on inside of combat pants and on flap under zipper; Div patch on jacket. Was a rifleman when Company "C" attacked Cassino and was last seen trying to get back across minefield IIE of Cassino at 860.222.
- Pruitt, Theron A. Pfc. 34708166 - 8D shoes; 15-32 OD shirt; 32-33 OD trousers; 36R field jacket. Company "K" while attacking Cassino Italy proceeded as far as a house at 856216 when strongly counter-attacked by Germans. Pruitt was in this house and was last seen being lined up there by the Germans, but is believed to be dead.
- Roguski, William A., Jr. Pfc. 31198217 - Height 5'10"; weight 150 lbs; thin light hair; blue eyes. Believed to be wearing ring with "Tunisia" inscribed on it. His upper front teeth were crooked (lapped over each other). Circumstances of death same as Abramowicz. Both of his legs partially blown off. Believed to have religious chain and medal on neck. KIA at 857.216.
- Williams, Patrick D. Pvt. 33601679 - No description available. Company "B" was attacking Cassino and were forced to withdraw to ditch at 866.213 when Williams was MIA. Exact spot not known.
- Aderholt, Hugh A. Pfc. 14148292 - Blonde hair; height 5'6" or 5'7"; weight 145-150 lbs. Was carrying a bazooka. Was wearing combat jacket, trousers and shoes. Pfc Aderholt was MIA during disorganized withdrawal. Company badly disorganized. It's not known what happened to MIA personnel. MIA at 860.222.
- Hughes, Bernard V. Pfc 31361486 - Height 5'11"; weight 185 lbs; hair red; Wore combat jacket, shoes, trousers. Was on patrol near Rapido River, just north of Cassino and believed KIA by machine gun fire.
- Kazebeer, Jack D. 2nd Lt. 0-1702978 - Age 26; weight 160 lbs; height 5'11"; waist 31"; dark brown hair. Was wounded by enemy when Company was attacking Castle overlooking Cassino Italy. It is believed that parents notified he is POW.
- Anderson, Daniel J. 2nd Lt. 0-493658 - Black hair; height 5'4"; wiehgt 130-135 lbs. (small stature); wore civilian glasses; OD uniform; knit cap; combat jacket, trousers (without bib). 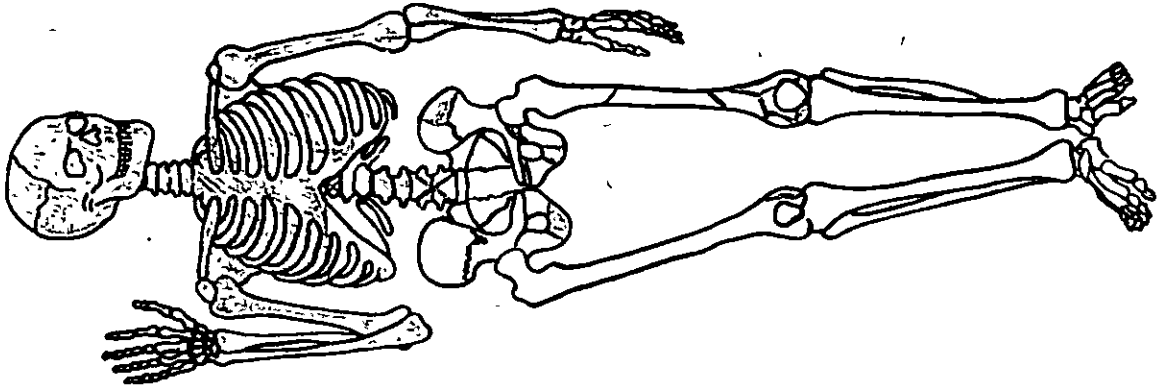
