1. The remains of Unknown American X-235 were disinterred from an isolated common grave in the vicinity of Vedriano, Grid Coords: M-O.19-3.38, Map of Italy 1/200,000 and interred in U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy, Plot 2-H, Row 93, Grave 4706.

2. With the remains of X-235 were found the remains of:

Berard, Leo J.	31 417 155
Sanders, Charles W.	34 832 390

Both of the above men were from the 351st Infantry Regiment, 88th Division and were reported Missing in Action 24 October 1944.

3. There were no identifying clothing marks found on the body. On the assumption that X-235 was also a member of the 351st Infantry Regiment, the names of the following unrecovered 351st casualties are submitted as the most likely possibilities:



3. Attention is invited to listing made part of report for members of 34th, 88th, and 85th Infantry Divisions, MIA or KIA from 19 October thru 28 October 1944 for whom notification of burial has not been received.
4. Subject listing is forwarded for possible association of members of designated units with Unknown deceased by tooth-chart comparison.
5. Original interment reports have not been furnished this headquarters.

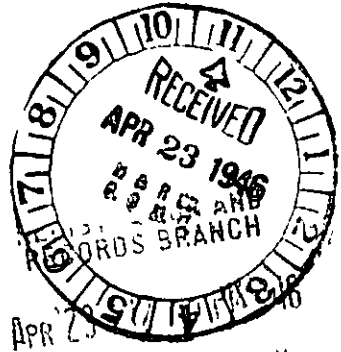

FACTS:

In a letter to this office of 4 March 1946 the following American dead were buried in isolated graves Map Ref. 019338 Sheet 88 IMOLA, Map of Italy 1/100,000.

- a. BERARD, Leo J. 31417155
- b. SANDERS, Charlie W. 34832390
- c. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER
Rank and Org., Unknown
Date of death: Est. Dec. 1944.

FINDINGS:

1. On 8 March 1946 a Crew from this GRU. led by Pvt. Michael F. Gregorio went to vicinity of Vedriano (Map Ref. 019338 Sht. 88 IMOLA, Map of Italy 1/100,000) for the purpose of investigating isolated burials.

2. Found graves with three white wooden crosses with these inscriptions:

- a. AMERICAN SOLDIER
BERARD, Leo J. 31417155 T44
- b. AMERICAN SOLDIER
SANDERS, Charlie 34832390 T44
- c. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER

31 - G.C.U was on the back of each marker.

3. Found three bodies in one grave, one on top of the other, individually wrapped in blankets.

4. Identification tags were found with the following:

- a. BERARD, Leo J. 31417155 2 Tags
- b. SANDERS, Charlie W. 34832390 2 Tags
- c. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-235 No Tags

5. All bodies were found in skeleton form, fingerprints were impossible.

6. Remains of U.S. Army issue Clothing were found on these bodies, no markings, no sizes could be found.

7. Identification of Unknown American soldier X-235 was impossible tooth chart ref. to GRS form, Fingerprints impossible body in skeleton form.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Being that Unknown American Soldier X-235 was found buried with the said American Soldier Leo J. Berard, 31417155 and Charlie W. Sanders, 34832390, the list of missing in the area of operations be checked against the tooth chart of X-235.

COMMENTS:

1. It may be that Unknown American Soldier X-235 might have been from same unit as above identified men.

2. No other information was obtained.


3. These bodies had been reburied by the British.

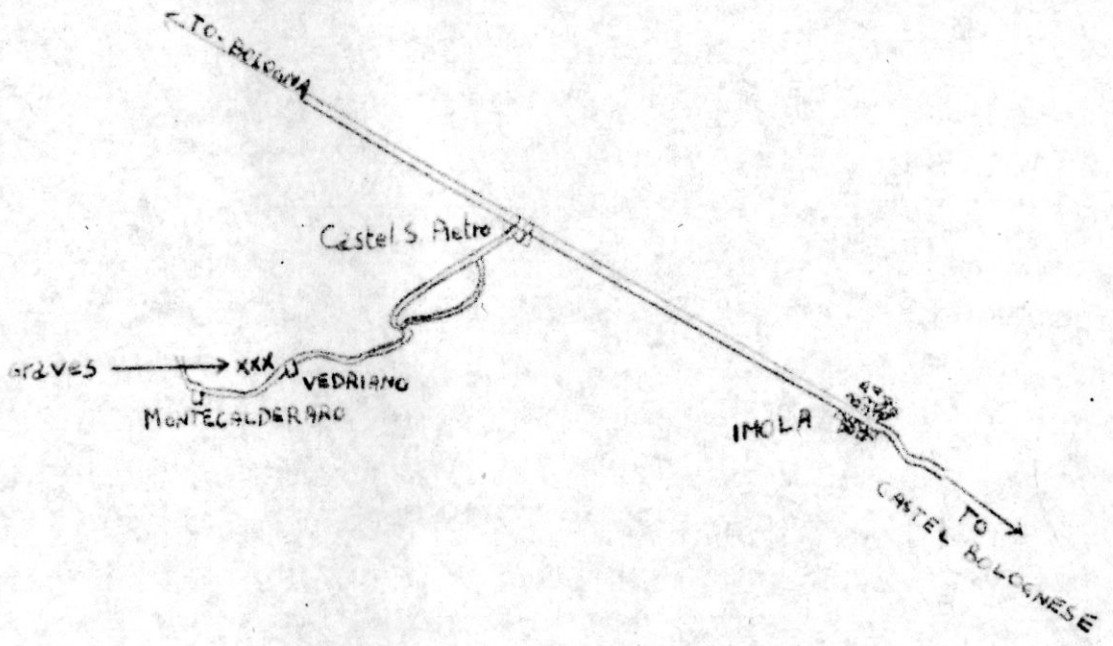
CONCLUSIONS:

1. BERARD, Leo J. 31417155 is buried in U.S. Mil. Cem. at Castelfiorentino, Flot 2-H, Row 93, Grave 4705.

2. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-235 is buried in U.S. Mil. Cem. at Castelfiorentino, Italy, Flot 2-H, Row 93, Grave 4706. As Unknown American Soldier X-235, until identification is known.

3. SANDERS, Charlie W., 34832390, is buried in U.S. Mil. Cem. at Castelfiorentino, Flot 2-H, Row 93, Grave 4707.

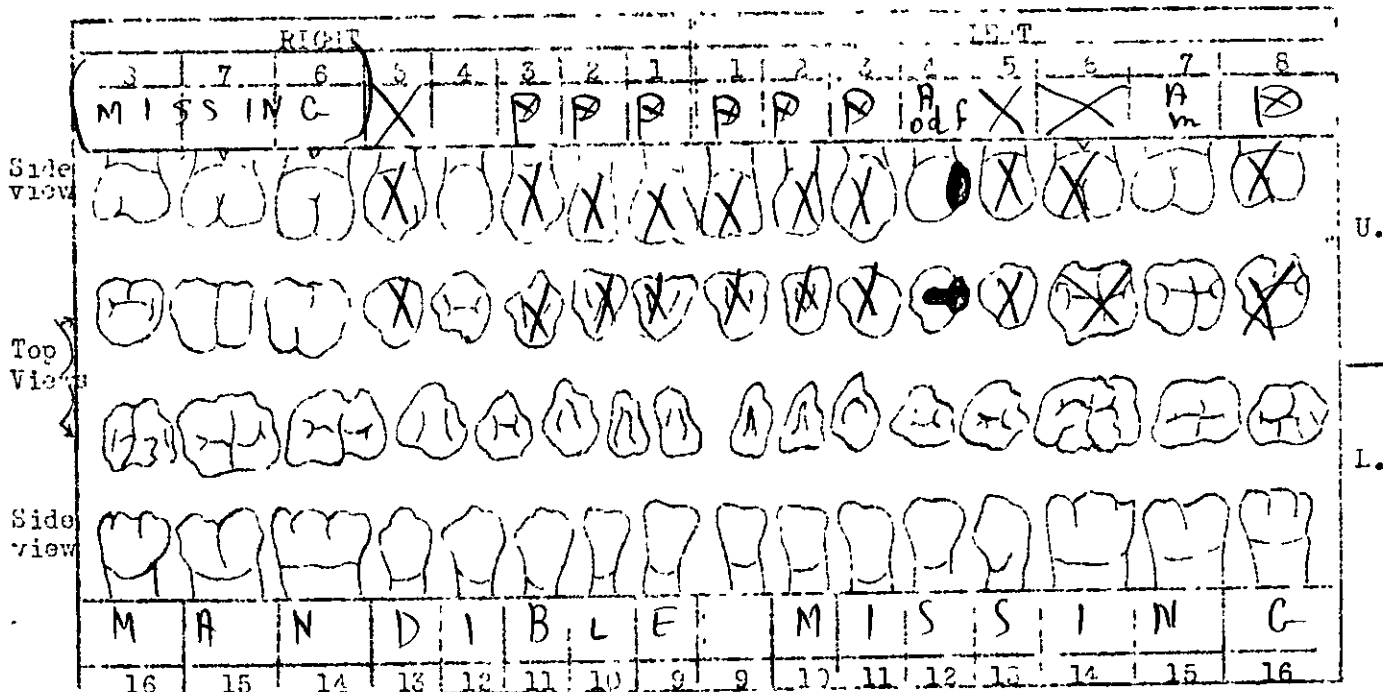
