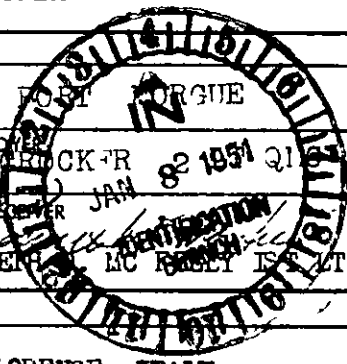
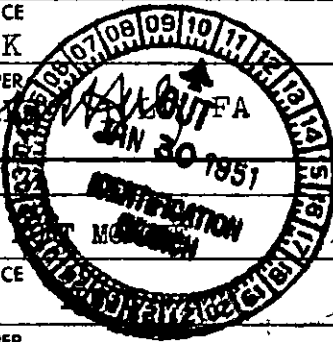

SUBJECT: Identification of Unknown American X-245 (Castelfiorentino).

1. The remains of Unknown American X-245 were found on the side of the mountain near Azzano, Italy, Grid Coords: U-9.9-9.9, Sheet 11, 1/200,000 Map of Italy, and were interred in U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy: plot 2-H, row 96, grave 4745, on 23 April 1946.

2. The listings for Unrecovered Casualties for this area have been processed to eliminate all casualties from Units which were not in the vicinity of Azzano.

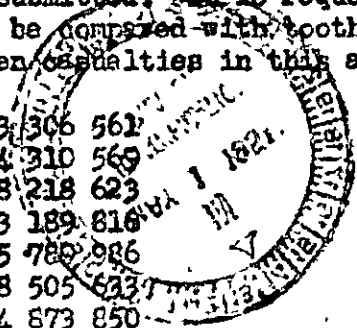
3. Records on file this headquarters and review of casualty listings indicate that casualties were sustained by the 92nd Division from October 1944 to April 1945, these specified dates were based on identified casualties from the same Division.

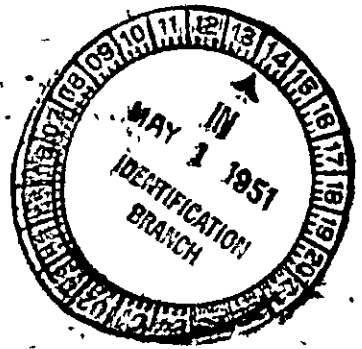
4. Recovered from the side of the mountain were only a few bones of the skeletal remains and a helmet liner with numbers "6339" found near the body. A check of the helmet liner numbers, failed to reveal any clue. Physical characteristics of subject unknown were:

- a. Right radius bone possibly fractured during youth.
- b. Toothchart available.

5. In an effort to establish identity of Unknown American X-245, a list of Unrecovered Casualties for February 1945 is submitted. It is requested that toothchart of X-245 on file, War Department, be compared with toothcharts of the following deceased reported to have been casualties in this area:

I. Submitted herewith is a field report of investigation of this office covering Unknown American X-245 who was picked up from the surface of the ground in the vicinity of Azzano, Italy Map Ref. U-9.9 sh. 11 Map of Italy 1,200,000.

2. FACTS:

Investigation team lead by Pfc Labon R. Jones of this Unit went to a mountain in the vicinity of Azzano, Italy and picked up the remains referred to in par. I. This body was found approximately 150yds from X246.

3. FINDINGS:

- A. Body was found on the side of mountain on the surface of the ground.
- B. No identification tags were found.
- C. Tooth chart was taken, fingerprints impossible due to decomposition of body.
- D. Part of GI sweater and one wool sock, no markings found, 1 helmet liner with the number "6339" painted on it.
- E. Only small part of body remains in skeleton form.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Check of numbers on helmet liner against serial numbers of missing personnel
- 2. Check for fracture of right radial bone in identifying body.

5. CONCLUSIONS:

Unknown American Soldier X-245 is now interred in U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy in Plot 2-H Row 96, Grave 4745, and GRS #1 prepared and will be forwarded to your headquarters.
