

Siccome in questa caserma dopo il 10 ottobre 1943, data di sbandamento dei militari dell'arma, si sono succedute e seguenti reparti:

ACQUAPENDENTE, ITALY.

ON THE 27 JANUARY 1946 SOME WORKMEN FOUND THE
SKELETON OF AN HUMAN BODY LAID ON THE FLOOR, IT WAS ABOUT 5'5",
IN HEIGHT. THERE WAS A HOLE IN THE HEAD PROBABLY CAUSED BY MA-
CHINE GUN.

ON THE RIGHT FOOT WAS AN ALLIED MILITARY SHOE,
THE LEFT SHOE LAYING ABOUT ONE FOOT FROM THE BODY.

FROM THE 1ST NOVEMBER 1943 TO 31 DECEMBER 1943,
THE BARRACKS WAS OCCUPIED BY CIVILIAN POLICE, FROM THE 16 JANUARY
1944 TO 16 JUNE 1944, THE SAME BARRACKS WAS OCCUPIED BY FASCIST.
FROM 16 JUNE 1944 UNTILL AUGUST THE BARRACKS WAS OCCUPIED BY AME-
RICAN NEGRO TROOPS, THEN BY THE FRENCH POLICE.

PROBABLY THE BODY WAS THAT, OF A PRISONER.

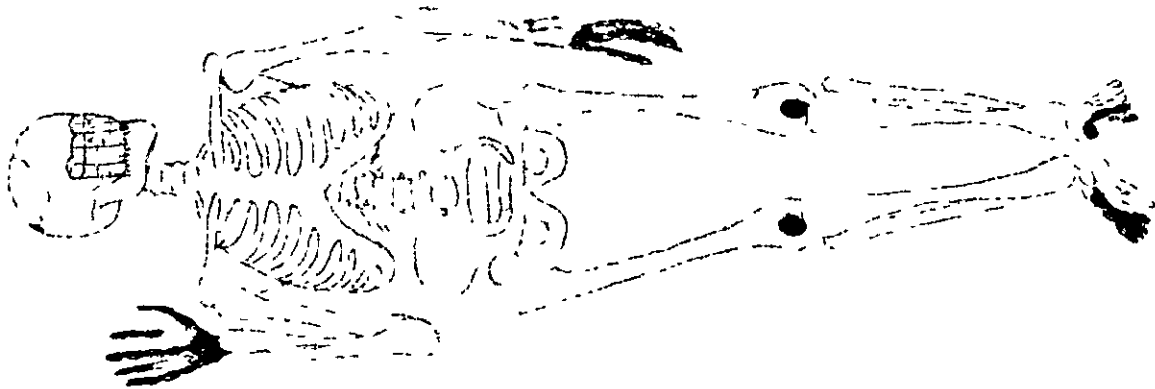


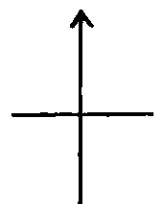
