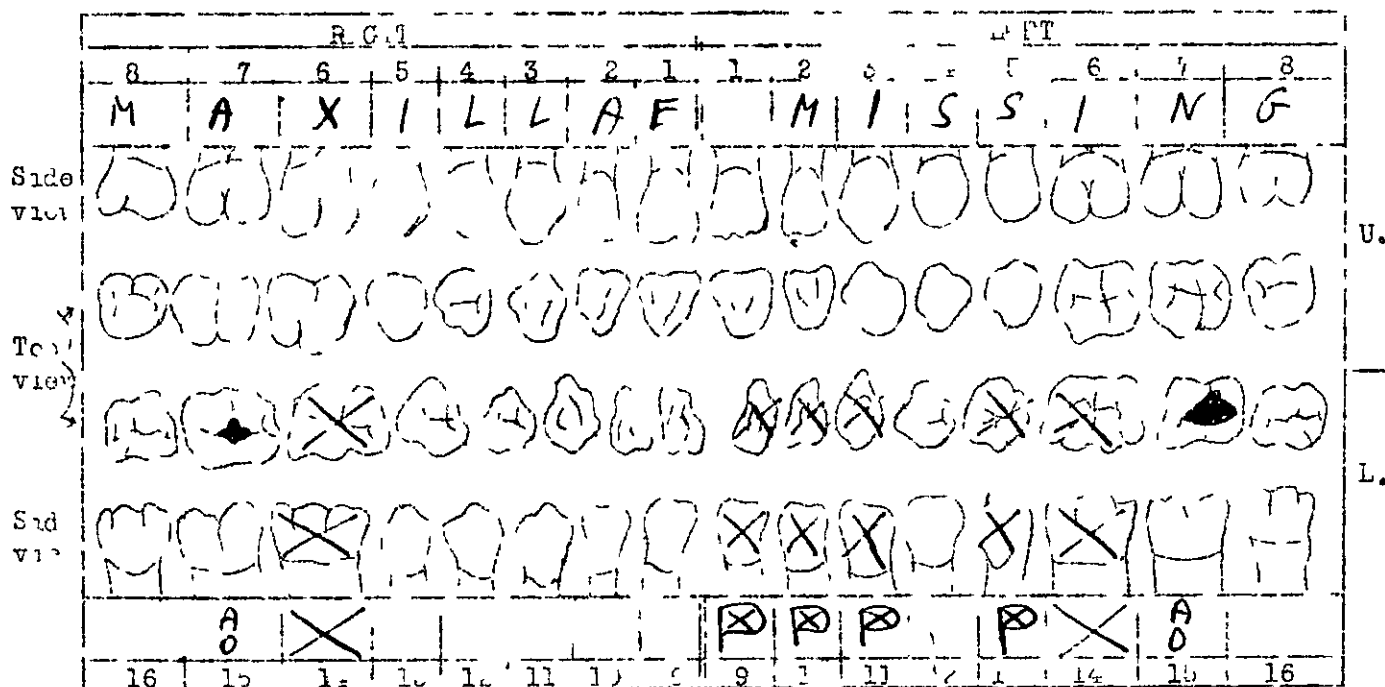

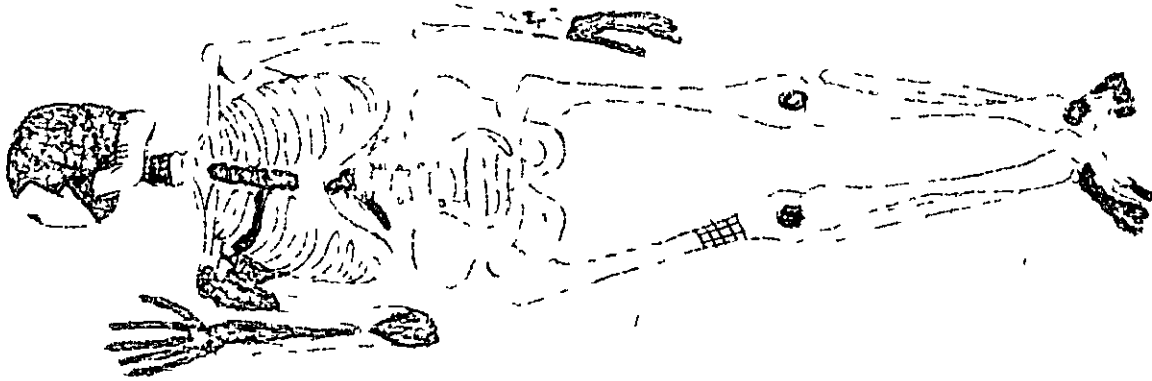

2. FACTS:

The investigation team led by Pfc. Labon R. Jones went to the above coordinate to exhume said American Soldier, the site was found with the aid of Civilians.

3. FINDINGS:

A. On the grave was a marker with these inscriptions, Sol. Americano.

B. No identification tags were found.

C. A partial tooth chart was possible.

D. Remnants of O.D. clothing no markings, S&D Service Shoes.

4. COMMENTS:

None.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the partial tooth chart be checked with missing personal of the area of the casualty.

6. CONCLUSIONS:

The remains of Unknown American Soldier X-263 are now interred in Plot 2-J, Row 89, Grave 4811, at the U. S. Military Cemetery at Castelfiorentino, Italy and QMC form-1-GRS have been prepared and will be forwarded to your Headquarters.

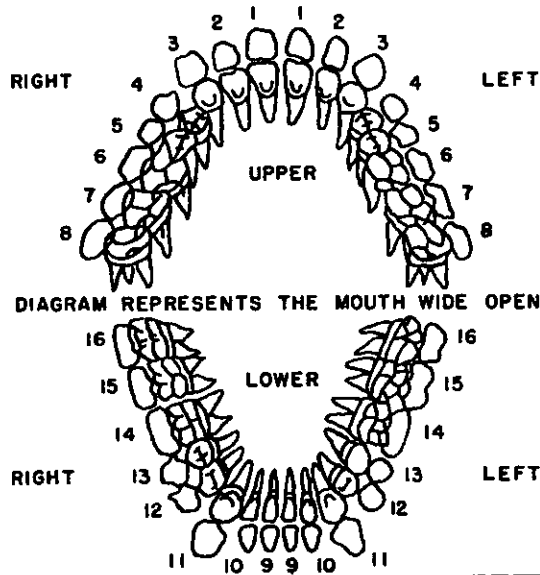


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN
