1. Submitted herewith is a field report of investigation by this office covering UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268, remains found on the surface of the earth in the vicinity of Seravezza, Italy on Mt. Canala. Coordinates (98.6-97.6), Sheet 104, Map Reference: 1/100,000.

2. FACTS

A. The investigation team led by T/5 Tadashi Ishida went to the above mentioned coordinates to recover said UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268 remains.

B. A civilian worker in the vicinity of Seravezza, Italy gave information to the investigation team that led them to remains of said UNKNOWN SOLDIER.

C. Following directions given by the Italian civilian worker the investigation team proceeded to the top of Mt. Canala. In the shell scarred area, shattered and scattered remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268 were found.

3. FINDINGS:

A. The following remains were found within a radius of thirty (30) feet from a shell crater.

LEFT SECTION

Six Ribs
One Radius (shattered)
One Ulna (shattered)

RIGHT SECTION

Ten Ribs
One Scapula
One Femur (shattered)
One Clavicle

Three dorsal vertebrae
Five lumbar vertebrae

B. Remnants of clothing found are as follows: Leg part of O.D. trousers, lower back part of O.D. shirt and piece of an undershirt. Burned clothing and bones seem to indicate that UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268 had probably been hit by a phosphorous shell.

C. Helmet liner with grade of S/Sgt., found with remains. No other identification marks of any kind could be found.

D. Area completely and thoroughly searched but other leading

clues as to positive identification undisclosed. A thorough questioning of civilians in the vicinity proved futile.

E. Elements of the 92nd Infantry Division were in this area during combat.

F. Tooth chart was impossible as head, mandible and maxilla were all missing.

G. Fingerprints were also impossible as remains were in skeleton form.

H. UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268 was to have been about 5' 10" in height, weighed about 185 lbs. and around 24 years of age. Assumed to have been colored as black curly hair was noted.

4. COMMENTS:

A. Area completely checked by our investigation team and also local inhabitants were thoroughly questioned but no clues could be obtained as to the identity of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268.

B. We have checked our Ground Force Casualty Reports for possible information but our files reveal nothing.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

A. None

6. CONCLUSIONS:

A. The remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-268 are now interred in Plot 2-J, Row 91, Grave 4836, at the UNITED STATES MILITARY CEMETERY at CASTELFIORENTINO, ITALY, and QMC FORM #1 GRS will be forwarded to your headquarter.
