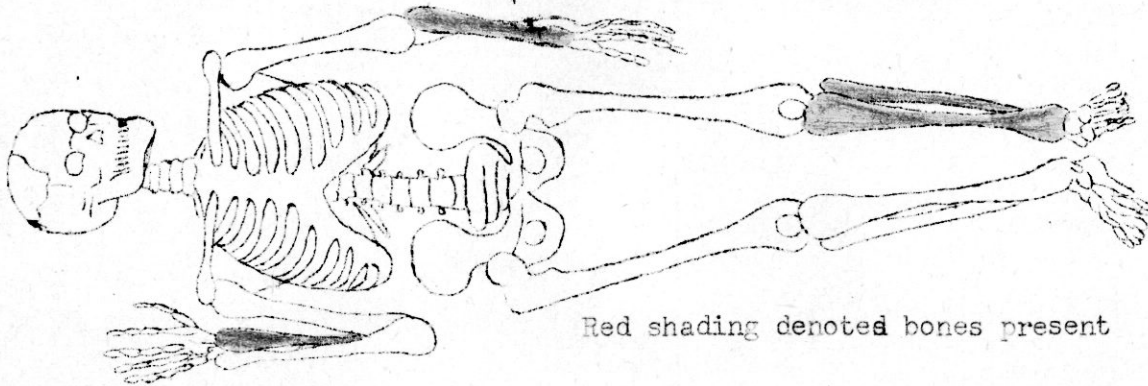

1. Submitted herewith is a field report of investigation by this office covering UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-270, remains were found on the surface of the earth in the vicinity of Massa, Italy on Mt. Altissimo, 1000 feet from peak. Coords.: (03.3-98) Sheet 96, Map reference 1/100,000

2. FACTS:

A. Investigation team led by T/5 Tadashi Ishida went to the above mentioned Coords.

B. The team had received information from an Italian civilian living in the locality of Mt. Altissimo. Claimed to have seen the remains several times but was doubtful as to whether or not they were that of a human being. The investigation team with the Italian civilian acting as guide found the remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-270, 1000 feet from the peak of Mt. Altissimo.

3. FINDING:

A. Upon arrival to aboveCoordinates, only four (4) bones were found.

B. The area was completely and thoroughly searched for other possible remains and clues leading to the identification of said soldier. Nothing could be found. Civilian guide expressed his opinion that possibly wolves in this area had carried off other parts of remains.

C. Area had been held and defended by elements of the 92nd Inf. Div.

D. Due to lack of remains it was impossible to estimate UN # KNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-270, weight, and age. Height was estimated at 5' 10".

E. Curly black hair was found, possibly that of a colored soldier.

F. Only remains found were as follows:

LEFT SECTION

One Ulna
One Fibula and Tibia

RIGHT SECTION

One Ulna

G. Remnants of C.D. clothing were found but no markings or identity of any kind could found.

4. COMMENTS:

Although there were only four (4) bones found we are carrying these remains as that of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-270 and due to the fact that these remains do not coincide with those of other bodies recovered in this area it can be determined that these four (4) remains are those of an individual.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

A. None

6. CONCLUSIONS:

The remains of UNKNOWN AMERICAN SOLDIER X-270 are now interred in Plot 2-J, Row 92, Grave 4838 at the UNITED STATES MILITARY CEMETERY at CASTELFIORENTINO, ITALY and QMC FORM #1 GRS have been prepared and will be forwarded to your headquarters.

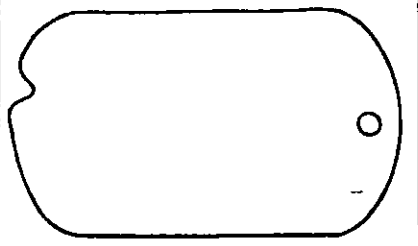



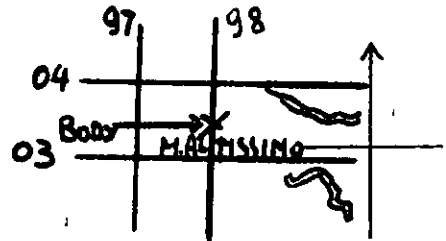
