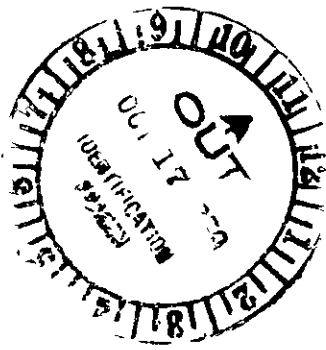

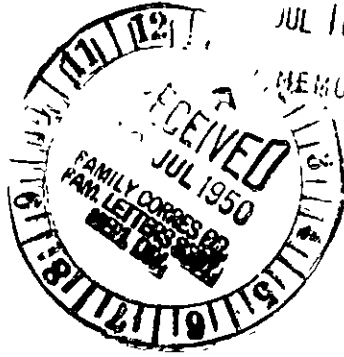

The attached file is forwarded to your section for correction of two errors:</p> <p>a. 333 Card Section (Mr. Sharpe) was bypassed on receipt of ltr dated 23 November 49, giving new grave location for Unknown X-283, Castelfiorentino; the records still show the Unknown and DALLAIRE in G-12-53.</p> <p>b/ While the letter shows the new burial location for the Unknown as grave 82, the Register for Nettuno shows that the grave numbers go only as far as 72.</p> <p>2. After discussing the matter with Colonel Allen and Capt. Odenwalder, I have informed ABMC (Colonel Gallagher) that the proper grave number is 72 and have asked him to correct his copy of the letter of 23 November 49 accordingly. 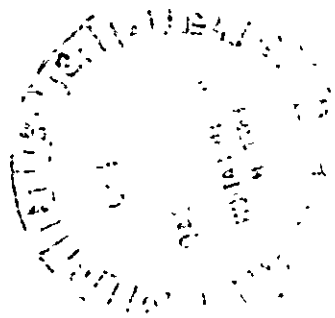

4. Request that all records your Headquarters be amended to reflect above change in grave locations.

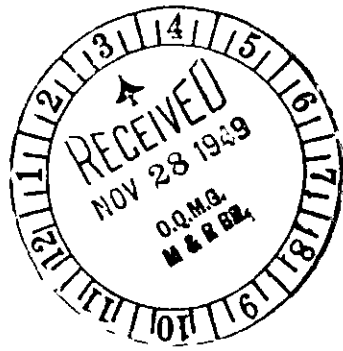
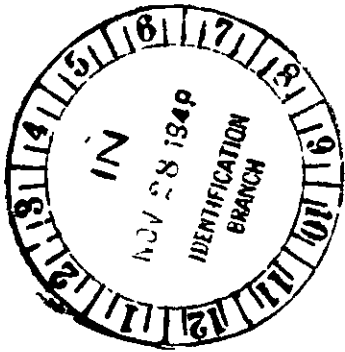

1. Submitted herewith is report of investigation concerning the recovery of the remains of Unknown American Soldiers X-283 and X-284, interred Plot 2-J, Row 94, Grave 4861, U. S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino.

2. Remains were recovered on surface of the earth, vicinity of Mt. Conala, coordinate (96.6-96.7) sheet 104 I N.W., Map of Italy 1/25,000 by T/5 Ryo Uchida, 2 October 1946 acting on information supplied by an Italian civilian, Adamo Baselli who is a resident in this vicinity.
