The Screening Section, Identification Branch, Memorial Division, OQMG, has conducted an investigation to determine whether the subject Unknown remains could be considered as a candidate for selection as the World War Unknown.</p> <p>2. The following information is the basis for a recommendation of "Eligible" or "Non-eligible".</p> <p>a. The Report of Burial for Unknown X-1, dated 8 November 1944, indicates that the remains were interred in Plot 1, Row 1, Grave 3, Fort Randall Cemetery, Cold Bay Alaska on 3 August 1942. Date of death is shown as 3 July 1942 and cause of death is listed as a "crash". No other mention is made of the date or cause of death and no association could be made between Unknown X-1 and any plane crashes of that approximate date.</p> <p>b. An examination of the remains on 4 June 1949 by Captain John G. Foulkes, Jr., QMG, revealed that the remains consisted of the following parts: Right Scapula, humerus, radius, ulna, left clavicle, left tibia, right foot and left foot. A re-examination of the remains, 27 July 1950, by Carl T. Noll, Decedent Branch, Memorial Division, revealed the remains to be in an excellent state of preservation. All bones found in the first examination were present in the second examination except only a portion of the left foot was present. The height of the remains were estimated to be 5' 10". No evidence of bone fractures or other identifying data concerning the remains could be established. Two GI shoes, left, size-eight and right, size-nine, and a portion of a white wool sock were found with the remains. No identifying marks were present on these articles.</p> <p>c. The remains of Unknown X-1, formerly buried in Fort Randall Cemetery, Cold Bay, Alaska, Plot 1, Row 1, Grave 3 are now interred in Row BB, Grave 15, Sitka National Cemetery, Sitka, Alaska.</p> <p>3. This remains falls in an Unidentifiable category as required of candidates for selection of the World War II Unknown; however the remains are not sufficiently complete to consider as a candidate for the World War II Unknown since large portions of major anatomical parts are missing. To insure that all candidates for selection as the World War II Unknown actually represent all of the recoverable remains of an Unknown American it has been determined that the remains should be as complete as possible with at least portions of every major anatomical part represented.</p> <p>4. 1. Submitted herewith is report of disinternment of remains interned in Grave three (3), Plot one (1), Row one (1), Post Cemetery, this station.
2. Disinternment was began at 0930 14 November 1946. At 1020 14 November 1946 the remains were reached and the box raised to the surface at 1040 14 November 1946.
3. The box in which the remains were interned measured approximately 24" x 18" x 12" and was in a high state of preservation.
4. At 1045 14 November 1946 the box was opened and the remains which were wrapped in a Blanket were exposed to view. The few bones contained therein were in an excellent state of preservation. A complete list of the bones contained within the box follows.
- a. Lower Left Leg with foot attached.
 - b. Right Arm to wrist only. Part of Right Clavical atchd.
 - c. Left Foot only.
5. No dental Charts could be made as no skull was found in the box and it is the belief of the undersigned that the above list of remains constitute the complete findings and burial made in this grave.
6. A Close examination was made of all bones for fractures that may have been of some aid in identification and none were found.
7. At 1100 14 November 1946 the box was resealed and was lowered into the grave at 1105 14 November 1946.
8. Reinternment was completed at 1130 14 November 1946.
9. A search of all available records was made at this station and no data other than that furnished on QMC Form No. 1 and forwarded to the Quartermaster General by Jack A. Morris, 1st Lt., QMC, GRS Officer on 4 August 1942 can be found which would aid in establishing the identity of Unknown X-1.

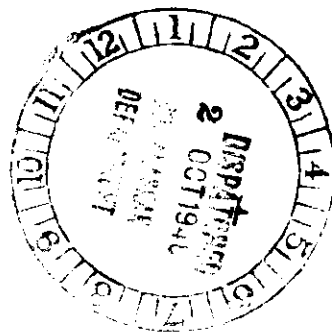

The attached reports of identification processing covering unknown X-1 and X-3 Ft. Randall Post Cemetery, and unknown X-12, Adak Post Cemetery, are forwarded for your information.

Very few clues remain in the case of Unknown X-1 and X-3, which might lead to identification. The two shoes found on Unknown X-1 are of two different sizes which actually places this case in a Group Burial status. Undoubtedly the extra foot is part of another remains involved in the same crash, but it is impossible to determine the remains to which it belongs.

Unknown X-3 is almost a complete skeleton with the exception of a few small bones. There are multiple fractures of all long bones, making measurement and possible height determination impossible. There are a few teeth in place on the portion of the mandible which remains, but these teeth are free of all dental work. In both cases there is evidence of previous attempts at identification.

The remains of Unknown X-12, Adak Cemetery contain a complete skull from which an excellent tooth chart was obtained. It is believed that this remains can be identified by comparison of this chart with those in file in Washington. An extra copy of the chart is enclosed for this purpose.
