remains should be classified as unidentifiable.



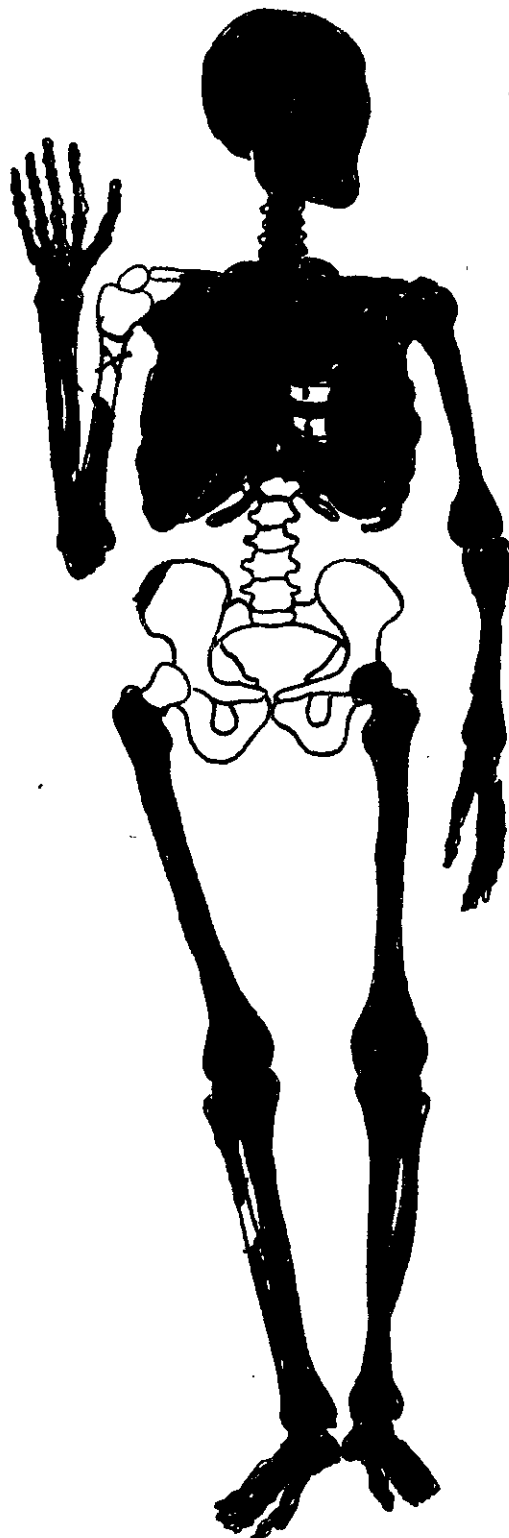
