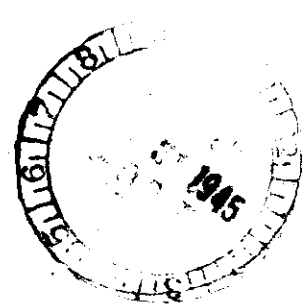

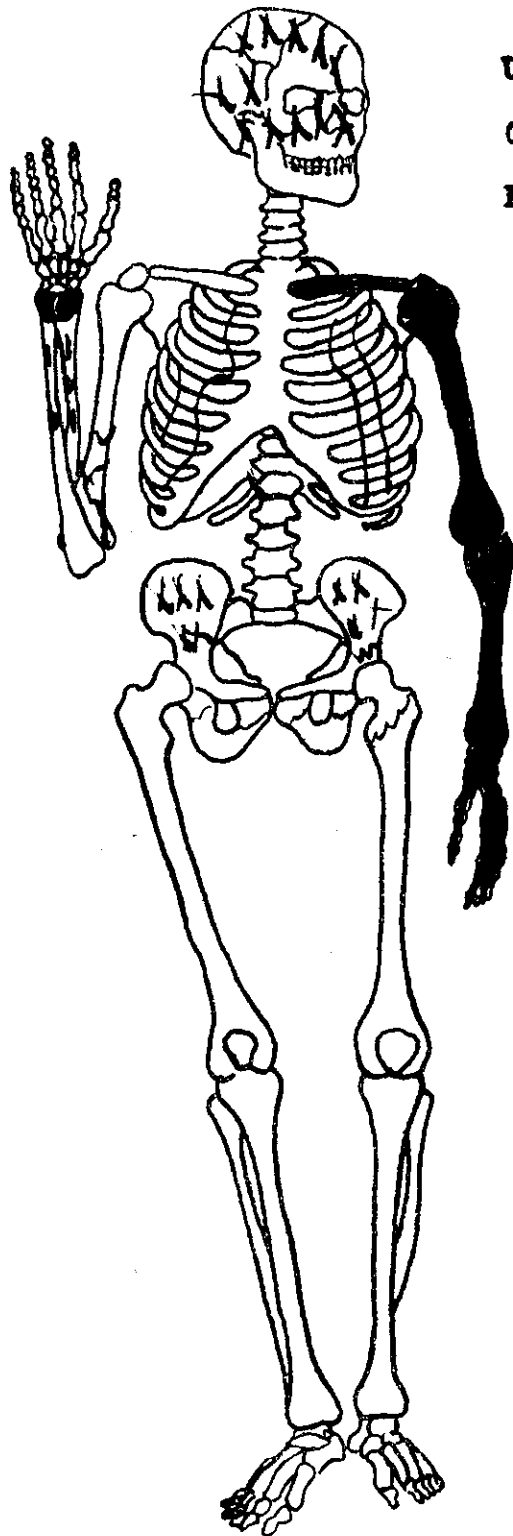



# TOOTH CHART



This dental chart is very important and should be filled in by the dentist. It should show 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. The teeth are arranged in two rows in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged on each side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), canines or cuspids (teeth which pierce the lip), premolars (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). A separate chart should be filled in to cover the following dental conditions: 1. Cavities (holes) 2. Restorations (fillings) 3. Bridges 4. Plates 5. Appliances (brackets) 6. Missing teeth. The reverse side for illustrations.
