SUBJECT: Report of Investigation.

TO: Commanding Officer, 473rd Air Service Group, APC #149, U.S. Army.

- 1. Following is a report of the investigation conducted in compliance with 11th Indorsement of Ltr. Hq's First U.S. Army, Office of the Quartermaster, Subj. "Unidentified Deceased, dated 21 March 1945".
- a. Upon checking at the Berlin District Hq Map Depot for the location of the town JUNGERSDORF, as noted in basic communication, or JUNGERSDORF, as noted in 11th Ind, no town was found under either spelling. However, a JUNGERSTORF was located in the general vicinity indicated by the Grid co-ordinates mentioned in 11th Ind, and it was decided to make the requested investigation at this point.
- b. Forseeing the possible need for some form of authorization to travel in the Russian controlled area of Germany in which Jungerstorf is located, the writer made every reasonable inquiry as to what might be required and where it could be obtained, apparently no special type to pass was available or necessary, and the CID people at Tempelhof, (who had travelled in Russian territory), suggested that any form of travel orders would suffice. Usual travel orders were obtained from hq 473rd Air Service Group.
- c. Starting early in the morning of 8 August 1945, a point some 10 miles north of Berlin was reached when Russian soldiers stopped our vehicle. Not being able to make ourselves understood to them we were taken to their Commanding Officer. After much language difficulty, he agreed to pass us through and entered our names and other information concerning us in a register. By this time the weather had turned very bad and so much time had been lost it was decided to abandon the trip for that day and start again the following morning. Arrangements were made for us to be passed through at that time and although some form of written pass was requested, we were assured that none would be required.
- d. On the morning of 9 August 1945, the trip to Jungerstorf was made without incident other than occasional detours because of unfavorable road conditions. Upon reaching Jungerstorf several Townsfolk were questioned as the Bugermeister was not at home at the time. Without exception, none remembered a December 1944 plane crash in that vicinity but did speak of an American bomber having fallen at Kittendorf (next town south), during May 1944. Driving to Kittendorf, information was received that seven Americans were buried in the village Church yard. Checking at the Kittendorf Church Cemetery, a common grave was found with a wooden marker containing the information that the following American flying personnel had been buried there 29 May 1944.

1. LARSON, LAURENCE 4. COLLINS, THOMAS 7. UNKNOWN

2. DICLIAN 5. PRYS, JOHN 3. CARTER, HENRY 6. GRAHAM, GERARD

The plane had crashed on the 28 May 1944 as several people remembered that it was a Sunday. No parts of this crash were available for inspection as the wreckage had been picked up by the Luftwaffe immediately. At Kittendorf there was no further information forthcoming on a crash during December 1944.

715TH AIR MATERIEL SQUADRON, 473RD AIR SERV GP., SUBJECT: Report of Investigation, dated 13 August 1945, Cont'd:

- d. Their only knowledge was of this one aircraft having fallen in their locality and that the seven casualties from it had been buried in the Kittendorf Churchyard.
- e. Returning to Jungerstorf, the Burgermeister was found and his statements corroborated all previously received information. Only one plane had come down in the immediate vicinity and that during May 1944. However, he did add that he had heard of an airplane going down in the vicinity of Varchentin, (next town south of Kittendorf), he did not know the date of this crash and suggested that the Burgermeister of Varchentin be contacted.
- f. At Varchentin we were stopped by Russian Officers and prevented from seeing the Burgermeister. Efforts to have them obtain the information for us proved to be without avail. We remained in Russian hands being passed from one headquarters to another until three days later when we were released at Copenick near Berlin.
- 2. From the information that has been obtained it is not believed that the remains of unknown X-217 mentioned in basic communication were evacuated from the areas covered by this investigation. It is suggested that the name of the town Jungersdorf be further checked for correct spelling and location.
- 3. Request that this communication be brought to the attention of the proper Graves Registration organization for disposition of the seven burials found at Kittendorf, Germany. This town can be located on: Central Europe, 1:100,000, sheet L7, First Edition, Neustrelitz, about 5 miles south of Stavenhagen.






