STATEMENT

I, the undersigned, state that on processing on 13 October 1947, the remains disinterred as Apar, Irving, Pfc 32784900, from Plot UU, Row 4, Grave 75, evidence of a mass burial was found. The remains of Apar were segregated therefrom and processed. The following portions of bones were examined and measured and could not possibly be a part of the remains of Irving Apar:

- 2 small portions of left femur
- 1 portion of right femur
- 1 portion of left ilium
- 1 portion of right ilium

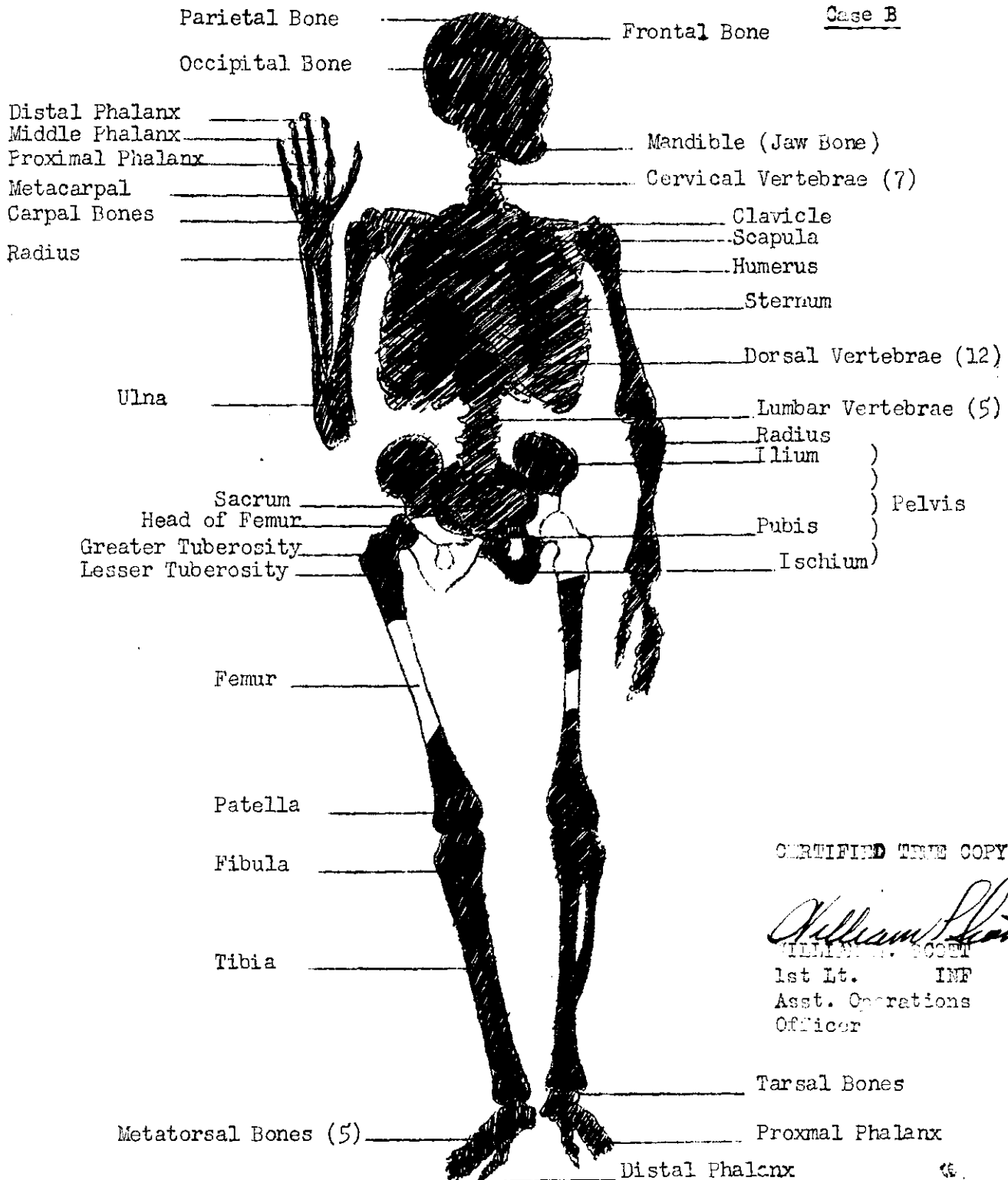
