11 May 1951

1. Case S & R # 78 has been processed and found to consist of skeletal portions for at least (3) deceased and possibly more.
2. Available information indicates that these are additional portions of casualties listed on Missing Air Crew Report No. L-197 (MC CHOARTY, BOATWRIGHT, GRAY ETC).
3. A study of skeletal charts previously made for recovered casualties of this Air Crew indicates that all portions now present in SR-78 actually are the portions shown as missing on those skeletal charts and consolidation therewith would be possible.
4. Available skeletal charts for cases identified as BOATWRIGHT and MC ELROY indicate that those cases are complete remains and would not be required at time of simultaneous reprocessing of remains concerned.
5. Segregation of SR-78 into four (4) cases (SR 78 A, B, C and D) has been accomplished pending further instructions.

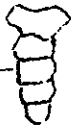

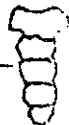
