The remains of S&R #81 and those of CIL #4762 were processed for possible association with TURNER, Robert W 2 Lt.

Processing revealed that S&R #81 consisted only of bone fragements which included skull fragements for three (3) remains. These remains were designated CIL # 4794 A,B,& C. The teeth found are negative for TURNER and were left with CIL #4794A which is also negative for TURNER. (See tooth and skeletal Charts)

CIL # 4762 could not be consolidated with CIL #4794A however it could be portions to CIL #4794B of C. Since no basis was found for consolidation it remains as CIL # 4762.
