Unknown X-63 was previously designated CIL # 1483-A, Cambridge or Brookwood.

Due to the apparent loss of pertinent papers, no record exists as to the origin of these remains. It is not definitely known whether the remains were removed from Cambridge or Brookwood, nor is there any grave location or any association with a recorded casualty.

Unknown X-63 can not be associated with any U.K. unresolved casualty nor with any U.K. resolved casualty, for which records are available in this headquarters.

In view of the above it is believed that X-63 must be considered Unidentifiable.

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. Remains designated as CIL # 1483, have now been assigned Unknown X-63 and were processed this date.

Mandible articulates with the skull but the skull does not articulate with the vertebral column due to absence of the atlas. Post-cranial articulations are partial but satisfactory. The estimated age and height are respectively 21-22 years and 5'9 1/2". The estimated weight is approximately 160 pounds. Shoe size is estimated at 10 C or D. Although articulations are not complete, this skeleton is that of one and the same individual. Race is white.

Cause of death - The characteristics of this remains (fragmented throughout) indicates a plane crash.

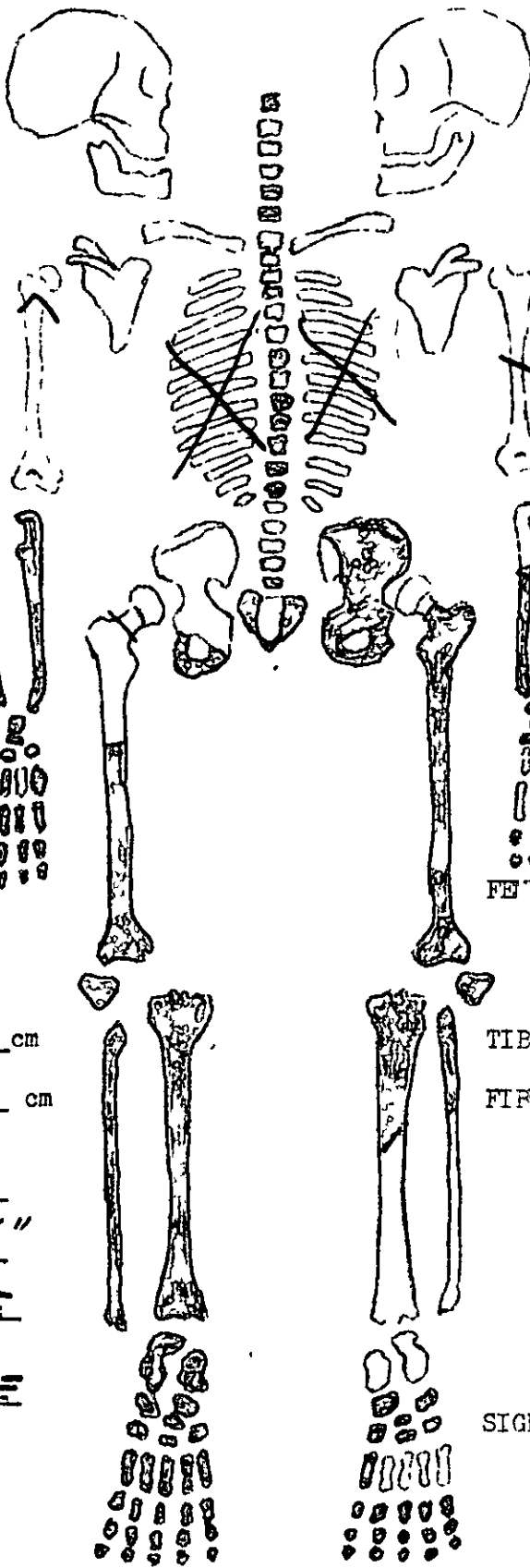

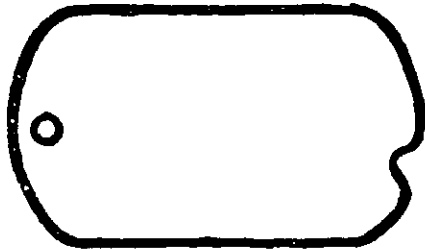
