1. Reference is made to the Report of Storage and previous burial reports for Unknown X-6, AGRS Mausoleum (formerly X-35, Finsch. No. 1).
2. According to original ROI a cigarette lighter with initials "W.B." and a pistol with serial number "1066555" were found with subject remains. Said burial report further indicates that the Unknown decedent was probably a member of the 22nd Bomb Group.
3. In view of the above identification clues, it is requested that available casualty records in your Office be reviewed in an effort to determine the possibility of associating subject Unknown with a casualty not yet accounted for. In the event that your findings would be favorable, it is further requested that this Headquarters be furnished OQMG Form 371 and any other data that might aid in the identification of subject Unknown.
4. No further action is contemplated by this Headquarters concerning this Unknown until a reply is received from your Office.

3. Attention is invited to Inclosure 1, copy of a Casualty Letter from this organization on 15 June, 1944. It is believed that this information may have a direct bearing in establishing the identity of the deceased person mentioned in Par 2, basic communication.

4. Organizational records of the issue of small arms by the 408th Bombardment Squadron(H), of this Group, were lost during the move to Leyte, P.I. That organization has no means of determining whether pistol #1066555 was issued to Sgt Warren R. Brunn, 36809708, or to any other member of that organization.
