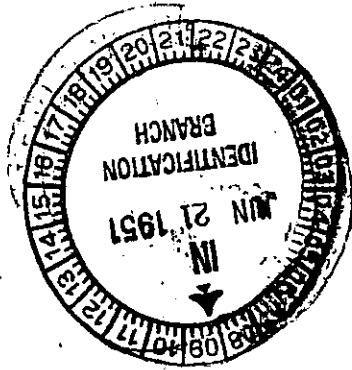

1. A thorough search of the records of this Bureau has failed to identify any property under designations given in Par. 1 of first indorsement or under the grave locations given in preceding second indorsement.

2. Attention is invited to inclosed copy of W.D. AGO Form 54 pertaining to a wristwatch recovered in New Guinea for any unknown of the ten crew members listed thereon. It will be noted that the identification tag bears the name and serial number of one of the crew and that the wristwatch cannot be associated with any particular individual.

3. Examination of the wristwatch discloses it to be a waterproof model "Westfield", the bezel, crystal and hands missing, not in working order, and bears no distinctive identification.

4. In the event that this watch is found to be the unknown in question, this Bureau should be notified to enable correction of pertinent records.

5. If the watch is found to be other than the one whose description is requested in basic communication, authority is requested to contact the next of kin of the ten crew members in an endeavor to establish its ownership.
