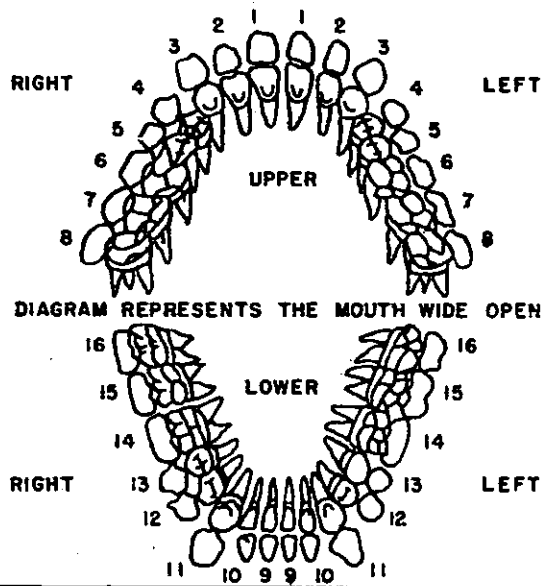


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

DISAPPROVAL OF FIELD BOARD FINDINGS

Field Board Findings received recommending the individual identification of Unknown X-1559 as Pvt. Wendell W. Brown, 35251505.

Affidavits from Pfc. Fawkes, Pfc. Carl and Pvt. Chambers disclose that Pvt. Brown, a member of Co. E, 126th Infantry Regiment, 32nd Infantry Division, was believed killed in action 19 December 1942, while attacking an enemy position south of Buna Area, New Guinea. All three witnesses indicate that Pvt. Brown had been shot several times.

The remains of Unknown X-1559 were originally buried 24 January 1944 in USAF Cemetery, Finschhafen #2, N.G., these remains were designated Unknown X-38. Remains are now stored AGRS Mausoleum, Manila, P.I.

Case concerning Unknown X-1559 recommended for identity as Pvt. Wendell W. Brown is being submitted for disapproval for the following reasons.

a. Additional dental data obtained for the decedent is in disagreement with dental chart accomplished for Unknown X-1559.

b. Documentary evidence is considered insufficient to associate Unknown X-1559 with the decedent.

It is therefore recommended that these Board Proceedings be disapproved and upon concurrence the Field will be advised of disapproval.
