1. The information requested on Unknown X-35 (Blosville) is as follows:

(A) Disinterment fails to reveal a body or part of a body in grave alleged to contain remains of X-35. Grave contains only burned remains of parachute, parachute pack carrier and a meter gauge from an aeroplane instrument panel. It is the opinion of the Officer in Charge of the disinterment that there is absolutely no part of a human body in this grave which is substantiated by the fact that there was no odor present.

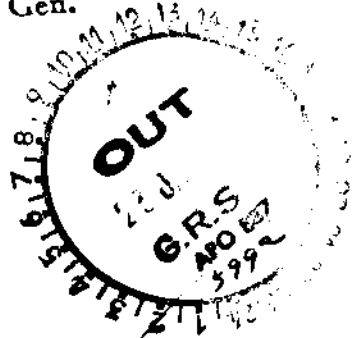
(B) The gummy substance in parachute cords left a residue that no doubt was mistaken by the parties making the original burial, as part of a human body.

2. In view of the above information this headquarters is advising the Cemetery to alter their records, to indicate Grave 156, Row 8, Plot K, as an open grave. The records of this headquarters are also being altered accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER MARKINGS ON DENTAL CHART

1. Give all information and description on dental chart as nearly correct as the condition of the body will allow. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridgework, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found.



Dentures (Plates) Draw diagram of relative size and shape of plate block in teeth attached and indicate retaining clasps on natural teeth with the word "clasp".

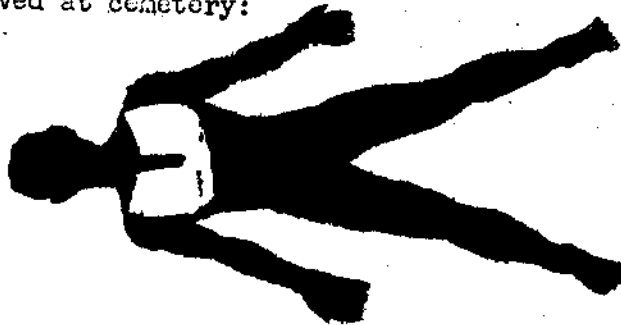
