There were absolutely no teeth found with CIL-3774. Even if the section of mandible as shown on chart #2 CIL-3774 attached to E.O was present, it could not be consolidated with Billingsley. It could however probably be consol, with Casatelli because it compares with his 371 and also he is missing the R. mand. from R-9 to R-16. The section of left femur & tibia found with CIL-3774 could not be consolidated with either Billingsley or Casatelli.


The estimated height for both remains is about 3" off.
