This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. See reverse side for illustrations.

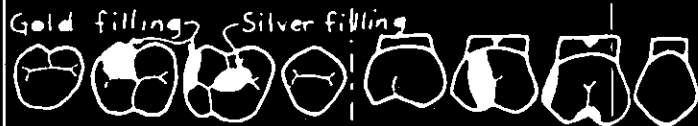

Remains were reprocessed simultaneously to effect proper segregation and placement of teeth. The following evidence and comparisons were made:

Remains	Height	Age	Hair	Wgt

The teeth placed with Batten compare with Form 371 for Batten. The teeth articulate with the skull. However, the skull does not articulate with vertebral column as the atlas (1st cervical vertebra) is missing. These remains were identified as Batten even though the height is three inches taller than that of Batten. It will be noted that a few fractured bones were used to obtain the estimated height. These fractures might not have fit perfectly making the bone a little longer than it actually was. This would make the estimated height taller.

The teeth comparing with Form 371 for Russell were placed with remains of X-149 for the following reason. The teeth articulate with the skull. But skull does not articulate with vertebral column as there are no vertebrae present. No estimated height could be determined. No estimated age could be determined. Inasmuch as the remains of Russell are not in custody of this Command and teeth for Russell were with Batten and the remains of X-149 were found with Batten, it is likely that the remains of X-149 and the teeth are of the same deceased and are part of the remains of Russell. These remains were badly burned.

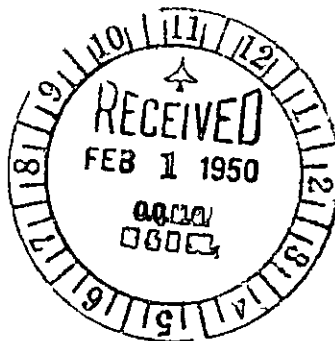

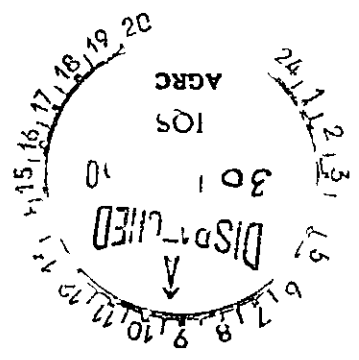

Upon processing the remains of Batten, Raleigh B , remains for two deceased were found. The anatomical parts for the second remains were wrapped in a sheet and were on top of remains identified as Batten, Raleigh B. The extra remains were segregated and designated as Unknown X-13043 and placed in a separate burial box. Teeth for two remains were found and were charted as charts 1 and 2. All teeth were placed with remains of Batten, Raleigh B , because it was impossible to determine which teeth belonged to Batten and which to X-13043.

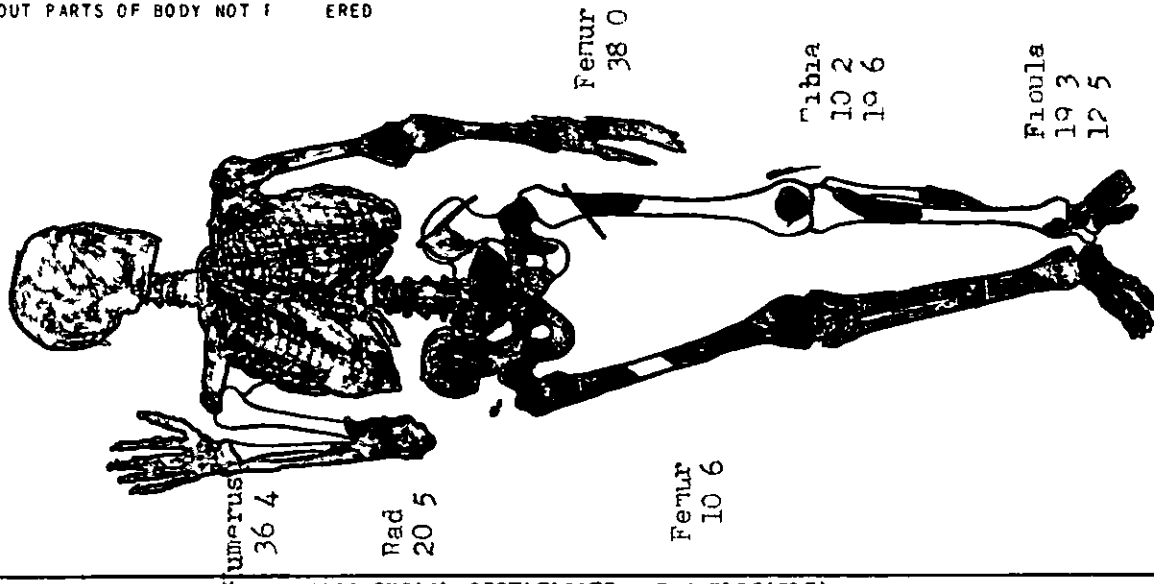

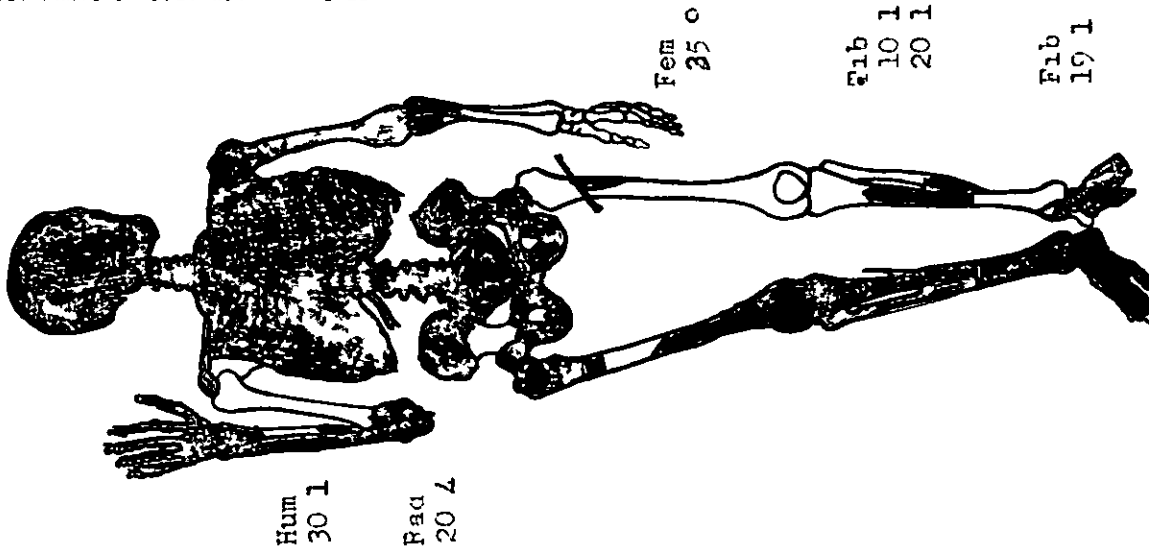
