2. Case papers indicate that X-5 and X-6 were recovered from a tank belonging to Company "C", 31st Tank Battalion.

3. Case papers for Unknown X-7, Plot A, Row 6, Grave 130, USMC Champigneul, indicate that X-7 was also recovered from a tank belonging to Company "C", 31st Tank Battalion, the same tank of which T/5 Henry S. Bruzdowski, 32213690, was a crew member.

4. Lt. Shaljian, Cpl. Ensminger, Pvt. Tucker and T/5 Bruzdowski were crew members of the same tank.
