1. Reports of Burial have been received in this office for Unknowns X-450 thru X-456, U. S. Military Cemetery, La Cambe, France. These Unknowns were killed in action five miles northwest of Pont-Hebert, France.

2. It is noted on the statements attached to each report that the deceased were buried in a common grave, by the Germans, together with George E. Tillet, 13047453 and Edward A. Bochniasz, 16016671, Infantry, whose deaths occurred in June 1944.

3. It is requested that records of your headquarters be searched for Infantry personnel reported missing or killed in action in that area, for whom no burial reports have been received, together with any other information which may be of assistance in establishing the identity of these Unknowns.
