Skull portions indicate the Caucasoid race.

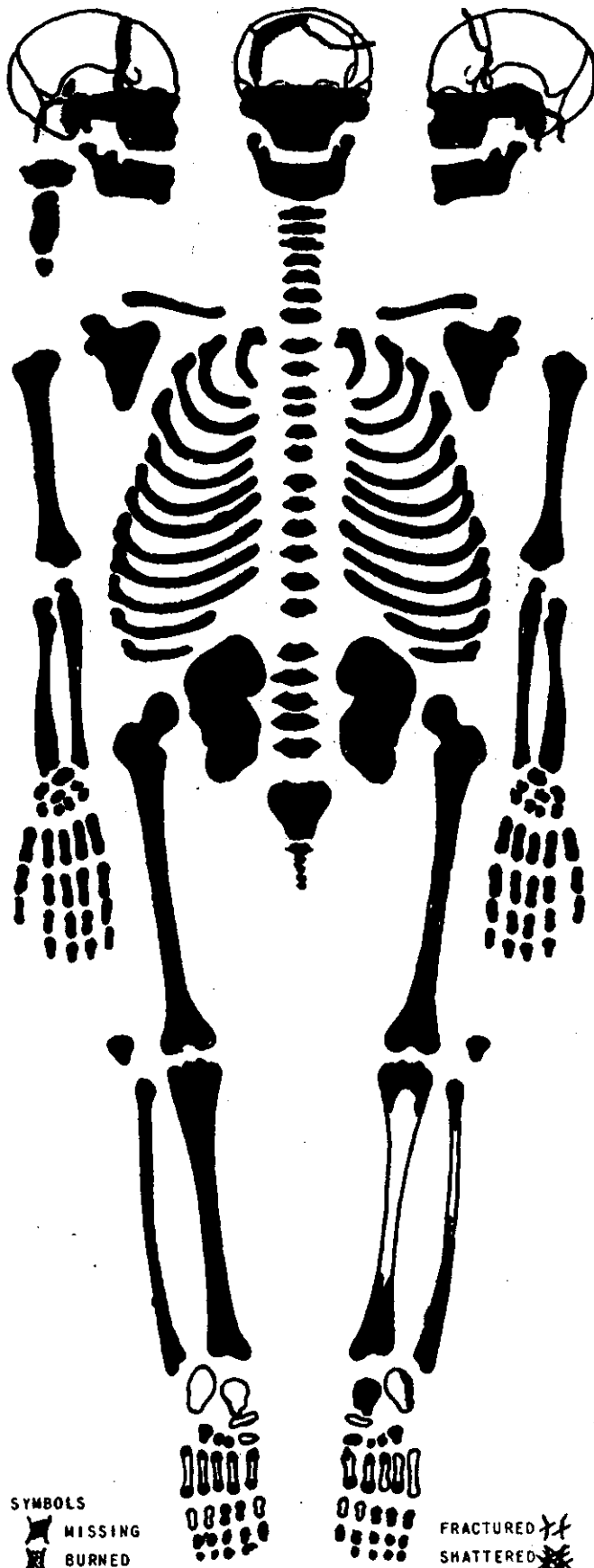
There is severe erosion present due to long exposure to the environment.
