Remains exhumed from plot 4 row 39 grave 6, Army and Navy cemetery number 2, Guam, as unknown X5, have been processed in the Central Identification Laboratory this command by Walter Thomas F. Nelson, anthropologist, and were found to be those of an animal. Board action was forwarded on 24 November 48. Recommendations of the board: "It is recommended that remains of unknown X5, Army Navy cemetery number 2, Guam, be searched for the remains of animal and disposed of locally. Request disposition instructions by radio to prevent shipment of these remains to Manila."







The remains of Unknown X-5, according to available information, were recorded as having been interred in Ulithi Cemetery on 21 November 1944 in Plot 1, Row 6, Grave 8, then disinterred and reinterred on 2 September 1946 in Plot 4, Row 52, Grave 6, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery No. 2 at Agat, Guam. Unknown X-5 was again disinterred on 1 December 1947 and sent to the Central Identification Point, Saipan, Marianas Islands, for processing.

PART II - CASE EVIDENCE

1. Interment Record, dated 21 November 1944, is attached.
2. Disinterment Record, dated 2 September 1946, is attached.
3. Disinterment Record, dated 1 December 1947, is attached.
4. Case Summary, Central Identification Point, AGRS, MARBO Zone, dated 15 July 1948, is attached.

PART III - DISCUSSION

The available information on Unknown X-5 reveal that final disinterment was made from Plot 4, Row 52, Grave 6, Army-Navy-Marine Cemetery No. 2 at Agat, Guam, and sent to the Central Identification Point at Saipan, Marianas Islands, for processing. The remains of Unknown X-5 were processed by Mr. T. W. McKern, Central Identification Point Anthropologist, and determined to be the remains of an animal.


PART IV - CONCLUSION

Based upon the statement of Mr. T. W. McKern, the Anthropologist, it is concluded that the remains of Unknown X-5 are animal remains.


PART V - RECOMMENDATION






