

I. in the AMM Cemetery #1, Plot 1, Row 14, Grave 27, 29 July 1944 as an unknown, then disinterred on 17 November 1947 and sent to the Central Identification Point, at Saipan, Marianas Islands, for processing. The remains of Unknown X-26 were processed on 20 August 1948 by Mr. T. W. McKern, the Anthropologist, and determined to be of Mongoloid Stock.

#### PART IV - CONCLUSION

Based on the statement of Mr. T. W. McKern, the Anthropologist, and a careful review of all available information, it is concluded that the remains of Unknown K-26 are those of the Mongoloid Stock.
