1. Reference is made to Restricted radio WAR 94117 this Office, dated 13 October 1950, pertaining to remains of Unknown X-46 Guam Cemetery #1.

2. Reprocessing of the remains resulted in the following:

(a). The remains designated Unknown X-46 Guam #1 have been identified as Pfc Frank R. Clark 887 880.

(b). The remains formerly designated Pfc Clark which were returned to the U. S. in March 1948 have been redesignated Unknown X-46 Guam Cemetery #1.

3. Efforts to associate the identification data for the unknown with that recorded for unresolved casualties from Guam have been unsuccessful, therefore the remains designated X-46 Guam #1 are being returned for interment as unidentifiable.
